

ELIGIBILITY FOR CONSIDERATION

Think about your **ORGANIZATION** and answer the following questions:

- 1. Is the organization a qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit or under the fiscal receivership of a qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit?
- 2. Is the organization directly serving residents in Pasadena with a focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math, also referred to as STEM?

If "YES," the Pasadena Rotary Club Community Grants Committee welcomes your application for 2023-2024 (see below for further details).

If you answered "NO" to either of these two questions, we thank you for your interest, but unfortunately your organization **DOES NOT** fit the *Pasadena Rotary Club* Community Grants guidelines for this year's cycle and will not be considered.

COMMUNITY GRANT GUIDELINES 2024

LOOKING TOWARD THE FUTURE

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. This year's grants will be awarded to nonprofits that provide **STEM programs or projects in Pasadena**. We support established nonprofits that have historically demonstrated prudent use of donor dollars with proven impact.
- Qualifying nonprofit organizations must be tax-exempt under IRS 501(c)(3) and serve residents in Pasadena. No grants will be made to grant-making private foundations as defined by the IRS. Funding priorities will be focused on agencies providing direct services to clients, not on passthrough grants.
- 3. A current member of the *Rotary Club of Pasadena* must endorse the application through a brief, written letter of support that needs to be included with the grant application.



- 4. Grant amounts range from \$2,500-\$7,500 depending on organizational budget size and proven track-record of community impact. Nonprofit institutional history within the city of Pasadena as well as with the *Pasadena Rotary Club* will also be considered.
- 5. Grants to any organization will not be made more than two consecutive years.
- 6. Full application packets, scanned into an emailable PDF format must be submitted by **Friday**, **February 9**th, **2024 at 5:00pm**.

PLEASE SEE APPLICATION FOR DELIVERY DETAILS – NO LATE SUBMISSION WILL BE ACCEPTED.

- 7. Full **scanned PDF application packets** must include:
 - Complete Grant Application form (please note word limit)
 - Letter of Support by current Pasadena Rotarian
 - Copy of 501(c)(3) determination letter
 - General Operating Budget for the organization
 - Current financial statement or audited financial statement

Please follow the submission instructions on the Pasadena Rotary Community Grants application form.

Once the application packet is complete, scan it into a single PDF document and rename the document – for example: [THE ORGANIZATION NAME Pasadena Rotary Community Grants Application 2024], and email it to grants@PasadenaRotary.com.
