

## For Rotary Year 2013-2014

### Preliminary Summary

- In 2010-2011 we Rotarians throughout the district donated **\$301,165.04** to the Annual Programs Fund.
- So then, after three Years in 2013-2014, we had 1/2 that amount (\$150,582.52) in District Designated Funds (DDF) of that, with the unused DDF of \$78,209.25 from last year: \$228,791.77
  - We are investing \$ 34,514.41 of our Rotary Foundation donations directly on Missourians or in Missouri. ( CAP Grants, Medical Equipment, Peace Scholars VTT ) - Totaling \$83,751.35 of good so far this year.
  - We invested \$27,500 to the future of World Peace and funded Peace Scholars. Totaling \$27,500
  - We invested \$30,117.00 toward Polio eradication. Totaling \$30,117.00
  - We are investing another \$69309.00 on 17 International projects in 11 other countries for projects totaling \$1,707,710.00.
  - Through our funding of all these projects, both locally and overseas, the Rotarians of Missouri - District 6060 helped through their donations to the Rotary Foundation to do:

### Educational Programs –

- **Peace Fellow Program –**
  - Donated \$25,000 to fund one of the 60 Peace Fellows.
  - Donated \$2,500 to the Zone 30 & 31 – Heartland of America Peace Fellow Endowment, a joint multi-year effort of the 26 districts started in 2006-2007 in Rotary Zones 30 and 31.
- **Peace Scholar Vocational Training Team for the benefit of our Youth** from Israel, Canada, Uganda, Kenya and Argentina-\$15,304.43. Brought 6 Peace Scholars, (3 teams) to the youth of Missouri in our district to learn, understand and put into practice the cause and effect of Bullying and how to address and solve current issues in their schools and communities for 3 weeks. These teams were hosted by local Rotary Clubs and housed by Rotarians in their homes.
- **Peace Center Vehicle- \$20,200.00 - for the benefit of Tracode Organization**, non-profit organization founded by Rotary World Peace Fellowship Alumni **located in Kampala, Uganda**. The organization was created to work in areas of conflict in Uganda, to promote political, religious, and cultural tolerance and consensus among the cultural, political, and religious leaders of the regions.

### Humanitarian Programs –

**District Grant** – we received \$28209.98 to give out to our clubs as Community Assistance Program Grants (CAP Grants). We gave out 28 grants to 26 of our Rotary Clubs for use in local projects totaling \$68,446.92. We received \$ 1000.00 to give out for a Dental Mission to Honduras for a total o \$4,766.00 of good.

**Global Grants** – 8 grants were applied for and approved. We authorized the use of \$ 21,887.00 for these. Total project size was \$ 1,146,863.00 AND 9 grants projects are in the process of being applied for and under review which we expect to authorized the use of \$ 47,422.00 for an additional project size of \$ 560,847.00
