

# Foundation Spending Summary

## For Rotary Year 2015-2016

### Final Summary

- In 2012-2013 we Rotarians throughout the district donated **\$294,892.00** to the Annual Programs Fund.
- So then, after three Years, in 2014-2015, we had 1/2 that amount (\$147,446.00) in District Designated Funds (DDF) plus the unused DDF of \$46,888.00 from last year, totaling \$341,780
  - We invested \$46,997.11 of our Rotary Foundation donations directly on Missourians or in Missouri. ( CAP Grants and Ambassadorial Scholarship) - Totaling \$56,610.00 of good.
  - We invested \$25,000 in the future of World Peace and funded Peace Scholars. Totaling \$25,000
  - We invested \$29,489.00 toward Polio eradication. Totaling \$29,489.00
  - We invested \$2,000.00 in an international project in Haiti.
  - We invested another \$68,500.00 in 13 International projects in 8 countries for projects totaling \$921,210.00.
  - Through our funding of all these projects, both locally and overseas, the Rotarians of Missouri - District 6060 helped The Rotary Foundation to do:

### Educational Programs –

- **Peace Fellow Program** – Donated \$25,000 to fund one of the 60 Rotary Foundation Peace Fellows.
- **Scholarship for Masters in Public Service** --Demas Solomon from Egypt and Arjola Limani from Turkey are attending the Clinton School of Public Service in Arkansas. Both scholars plan to use their degrees in work dedicated to poor families in their home countries. Cost: \$80,000.00 Contribution: \$2,000
- **Scholarship for Masters Degree in Conflict Transformation and Social Justice**--Laney Lenox from Ireland is attending Queens University in Belfast. Cost: \$34,500.00 Contribution: \$500
- **District Ambassadorial Scholarship** – St. Louis resident Gretchen Kohl just completed her Masters Degree in Specialized Economic Analysis at the Barcelona Graduate School of Economics in Spain. She plans to use her expertise to assist developing nations, preferably in South America. \$25,000

### Humanitarian Programs –

**District Grant** – we awarded \$28,799.00 to our clubs as Community Assistance Program Grants (CAP Grants). We gave out 32 grants to 27 of our Rotary Clubs for use in local projects totaling \$68,513.46.

**District International Grant**-- we awarded \$2,000 as a match to the Rotary Club of Cape Girardeau for a literacy project in Haiti.

**Global Grants** – 9 grants were applied for and approved. We authorized the use of \$23,500.00 for these. Total project size was \$616,663.00.

AND 4 grant projects are in the process of being applied for or are under review, to which we have committed \$40,000.00 for an additional project size of \$236,547.00.
