

For Rotary Year 2011-2012

Summary

- In 2008-2009 we Rotarians throughout the district donated **\$313,120.92** to the Annual Programs Fund.
- So then, after three Years in 2011-2012, we had 1/2 that amount (\$156,560.46) in District Designated Funds (DDF) of that:
 - We invested \$ 40,500 of our Rotary Foundation donations directly on Missourians or in Missouri. (CAP Grants, Ambassadorial Scholar)- Totaling \$58,671.81
 - We invested \$27,500 to the future of World Peace and funded Peace Scholars. Totaling \$27,500
 - We invested \$31,312.09 toward Polio eradication. Totaling \$31,312.09
 - We invested another \$59,354 on 14 International projects in 11 other countries for projects totaling \$1,267,184.
 - We invested \$2000 to help ship donated medical equipment from the UK to Mali. Totaling \$2,000
 - Through our funding of all these projects, both locally and overseas, the Rotarians of Missouri - District 6060 helped through their donations to the Rotary Foundation to do:

Educational Programs –

- **Academic Year Ambassadorial Scholarship** – (Greta Schuler) – \$25,000. Greta is in Johannesburg, South Africa pursuing a master's degree in forced migration at the University of the Witwatersrand's African Centre for Migration and Society.
- **Peace Fellow Program** –
 - Donated \$25,000 to fund one of the 60 Peace Fellows.
 - Donated \$2,500 to the Zone 30 & 31 – Heartland of America Peace Fellow Endowment, a joint multi-year effort of the 26 districts in Rotary Zones 30 and 31.

Humanitarian Programs –

District Grant – we received \$15,500 to give out to our clubs as Community Assistance Program Grants (CAP Grants). We gave out 16 grants to 15 of our Rotary Clubs for use in local projects totaling \$33,671.87

We gave \$2,000 to the Rotary RC Bamako Amitié, Mali: Rotarian Sunny Akuopha - District #9100 help fund shipping of Donated Medical Equipment to Local Community Hospital

Global Grants – 12 grants were applied for and approved. We authorized the use of \$59,354.00 for these and 2 grants projects applied for and under review.
Total project size was \$ 1,267,184.00
