

For Rotary Year 2010-2011

Educational Programs –

- **Academic Year Ambassadorial Scholarship** – (Erik Elftink) – \$25,000. Studied International Finance in The Netherlands at Maastricht University, School of Business and Economics .
- **Peace Fellow Program** –
 - Donated \$25,000 to fund one of the 60 Peace Fellows.
 - Donated \$2,500 to the Zone 30 & 31 – Heartland of America Peace Fellow Endowment, a joint multi-year effort of the 26 districts in Rotary Zones 30 and 31.
- **Group Study Exchange** – to Mexico District 4170 - \$7581.70. Sent our team of six Missourians to Mexico to live in Rotarian homes and travel throughout the district for four weeks.

Humanitarian Programs –

District Grant – we received \$23,000 to give out to our clubs as Community Assistance Program Grants (CAP Grants). We gave out 23 grants to 21 of our Rotary Clubs for use in local projects.

Global Grants – 11 grants were applied for and approved. We authorized the use of \$38,057.00 for these projects. Total project size was \$440,519.00 .

Summary

- In 2007-2008 we Rotarians throughout the district donated \$358,224.74 to the Annual Programs Fund.
- Then, in 2010-2011:
 - We invested \$ 55,581.70 of our Rotary Foundation donations directly on Missourians or in Missouri.
 - We invested \$27,500 to the future of World Peace and funded Peace Scholars.
 - We invested \$37,193.00 toward Polio eradication.
 - We invested another \$38,057 on 11 International projects in 9 other countries.
 - Through our funding of all these projects, both locally and overseas, we also partially controlled the spending of an additional \$440,519.00
 - For a grand total of 560,793.70 in projects to Do Good in the World.
