

ROTARY DISTRICT 6360 FOUNDATION KARL SANDELIN GRANTS

GRANT PROPOSALS ARE DUE APRIL 30

The Rotary District 6360 Foundation Karl Sandelin Grants provide funds to Rotary Clubs within District 6360 for community service projects. Special consideration is given to requests meeting one or more of the following conditions:

- Projects that benefit the community most meaningfully, benefit the greatest number of people in the community and those groups with the greatest degree of need.
- Seed money to launch new or pilot programs that, if successful, should be able to generate its own future support.
- Capital expenditures necessary for important charitable or civic programs.
- Special programs which complement the precepts of Rotary.
- Projects that garner financial and other support from those not directly involved with the local Rotary Club.
- Projects where the local Rotary Club is actively involved in the project.
- Projects that make the public visibly aware of Rotary's involvement and support.

Grant Application Guidelines

For a grant request to be considered it must meet the following:

- The deadline for applications is **April 30** of each year. Grants will be voted upon by the board at its following June meeting.
- To be considered for a grant, the application must be complete including the appropriate club signatures.
- Grant dollars requested must be at least \$500 and not exceeding \$5,000.
- A Club may only apply for one grant per year.
- Clubs must match grants dollar for dollar. In kind contributions will not be considered.
- Grant applications from Clubs with outstanding final reports or have not returned unused funds from previous grants will not be considered.
- Awareness that the grant funds awarded can only be expended for the activities outlined in the grant proposal and unused funds are to be returned to the Rotary District 6360 Foundation .

IMPORTANT – Grant proposals for maintenance or operating funds generally will not be considered for funding. Proposals requesting consecutive or multi-year funding are not funded. Also, if available funds are limited, priority will be given to clubs that have not received funds in the prior year.
