Empowering Women Entrepreneurship In Serbia Global Grants Project



EQUIP WOMEN
ENTREPRENEURS

➤ **Empowering Women Entrepreneurship in Serbia**

- This is a **Humanitarian Project** addressing community needs which will produce sustainable and measurable outcomes. **Serbian Rotarians are partnering with Women Entrepreneurs Association in Serbia.**
- In today's modern society, entrepreneurship is considered to be the driver of economic and social development and the important source of competitive advantage.
- The main objective of the project is to *identify business and environmental barriers* female entrepreneurs are confronted in their everyday business activities and difficulties in **accessing the necessary information about potential markets and technology** and even the potential sources for their **financing**.
- At the same time, they are **facing family care activities and other social norms** within the community in which they live.

➤ **Empowering Women Entrepreneurship in Serbia**

- An assessment was conducted with the help from Rotary clubs from different parts of Serbia to receive the **women entrepreneurship challenges in Serbia.**
- **Focus Groups were conducted with more than 50 females, ages between 35 and 55 years old, some of them are already in business and some have business plans to start their own production in their fields.**
- **The goal is to empower marginalized communities by providing access to economic opportunities and services.** At the same time, they are facing with family care activities and other social norms within the community in which they live.
- The **measure of success** to the number of women entrepreneurs (Max. 20) trained and supported will be through direct observation, grants and records. Their progress will be evaluated each year.
- The project will take place during **September 2022 through September 2023.**

➤ **Empowering Women Entrepreneurship in Serbia**

- **Host Rotarians will conduct fundraising and find sponsors in their local communities** in order to provide support in the area of women entrepreneurship , in their home towns.
- **International Rotarians** will help in fundraising and will have advisory role through whole process.
- The project has been **approved and funding** is in place.
- The local team in Serbia has **started the process of selection of Women Entrepreneurs** for training.

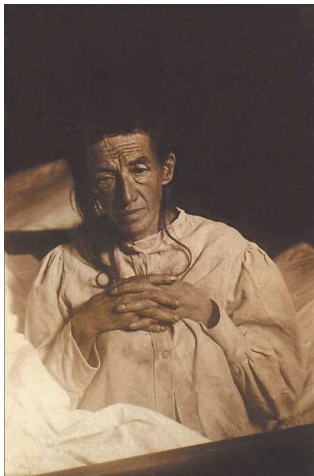

Auguste Deter and Alois Alzheimer



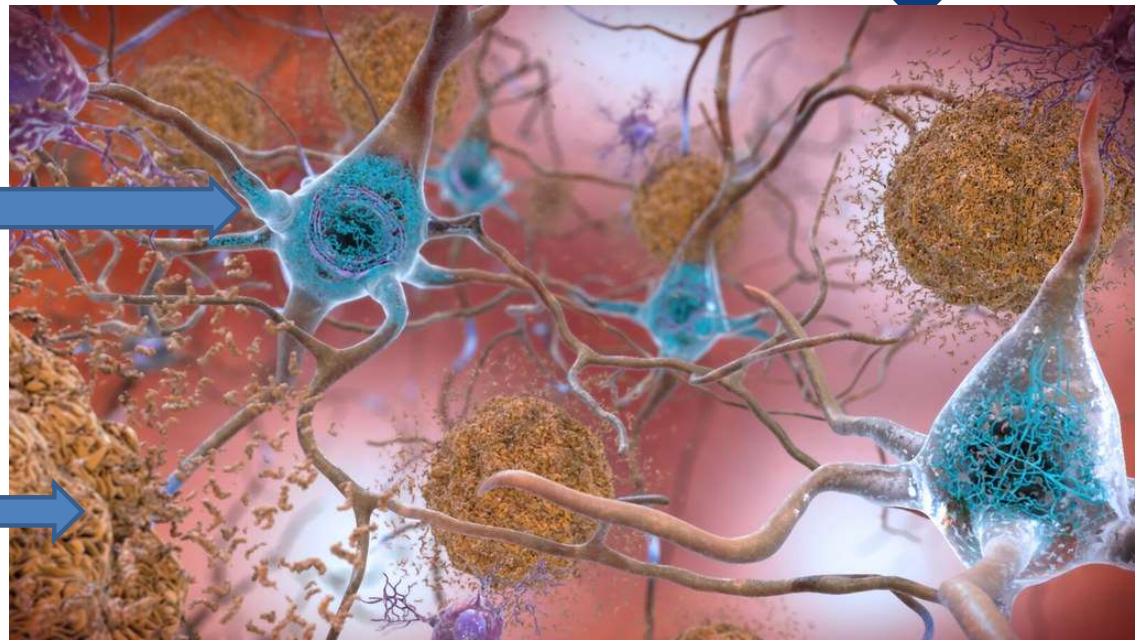

Every dollar donated goes into a research grant!

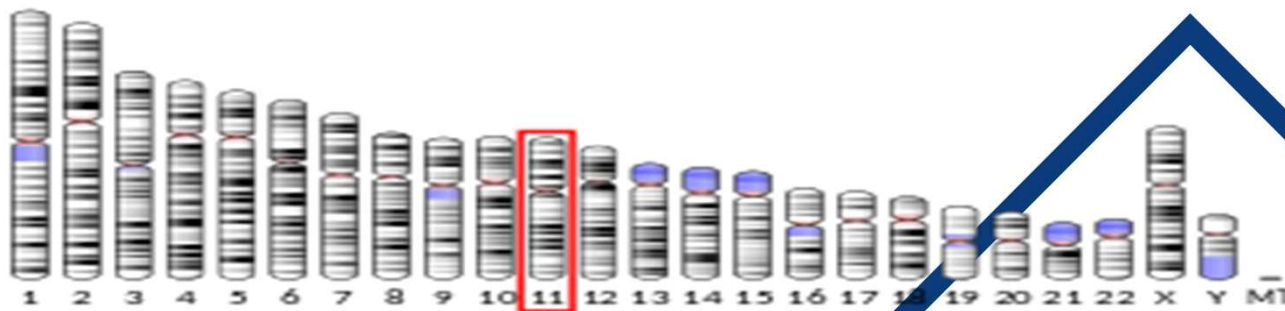


Discovery of LR 11

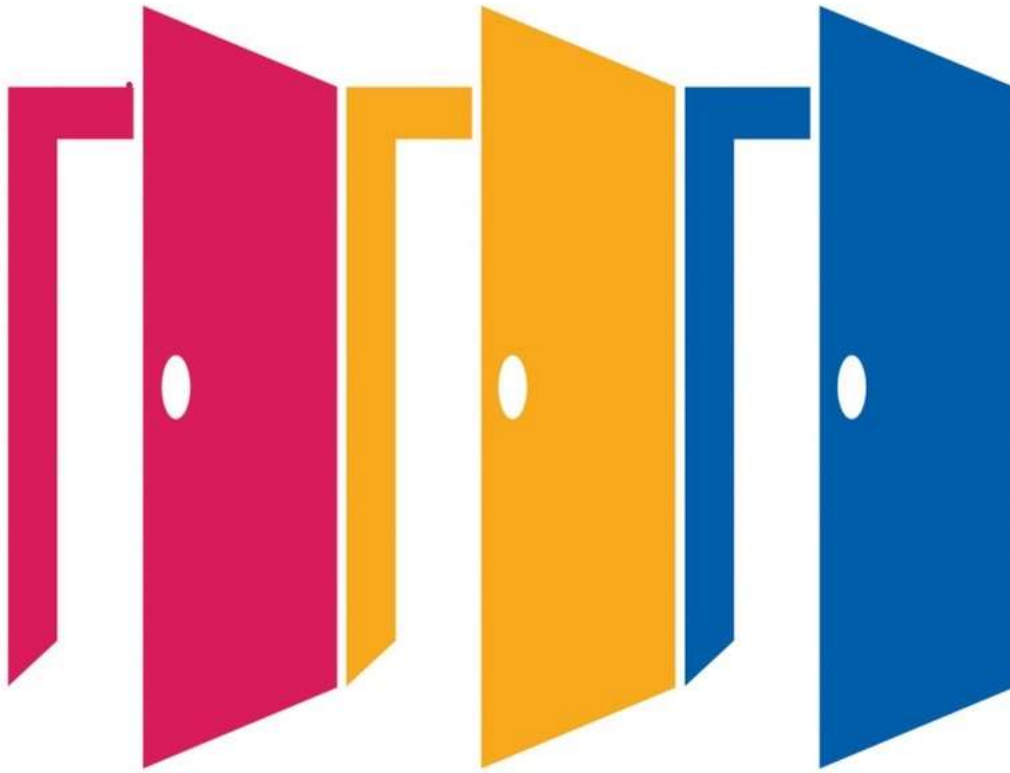
