A Peace Pole is an internationally-recognized symbol of the hopes and dreams of the entire human family, standing vigil in silent prayer for peace on earth. Each Peace Pole bears the message ***May Peace Prevail on Earth*** in different languages on each of its four or six sides. There are estimated over 250,000 Peace Poles in every country in the world dedicated as monuments to peace.

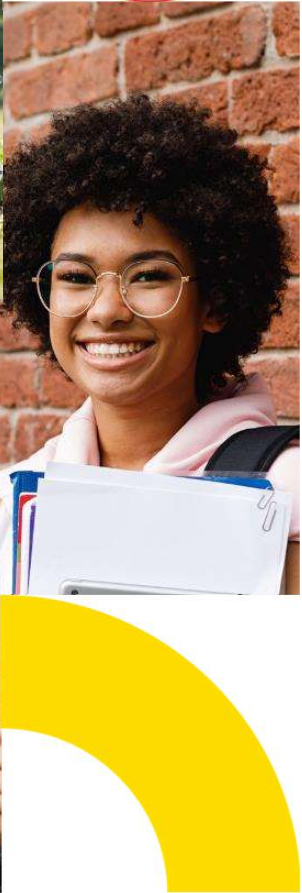
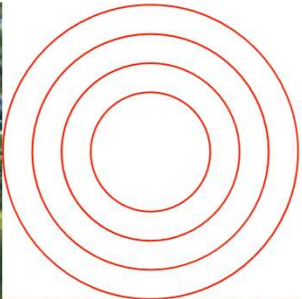

children in the U.S. is a victim of sexual abuse before the age of 18.

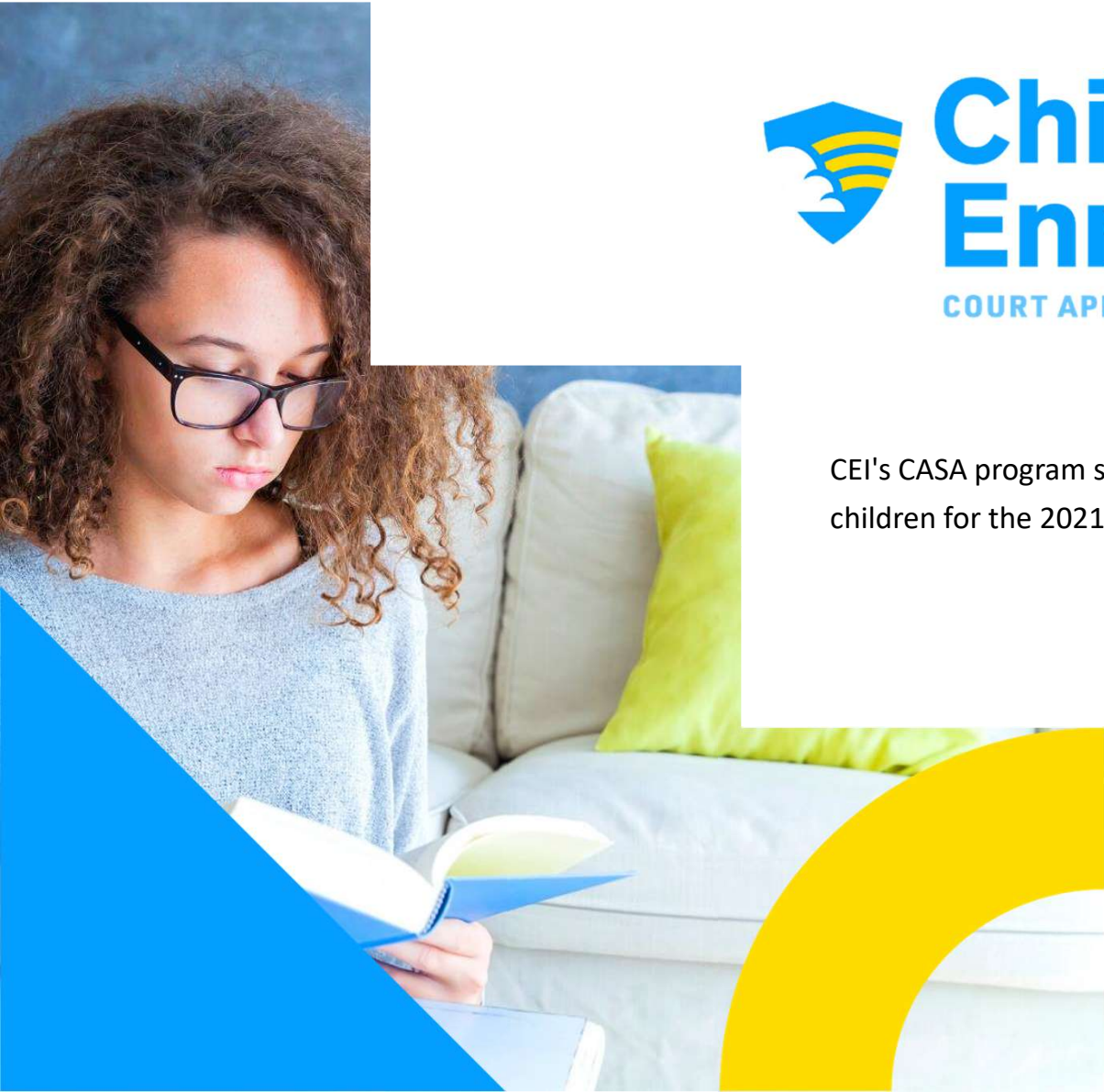

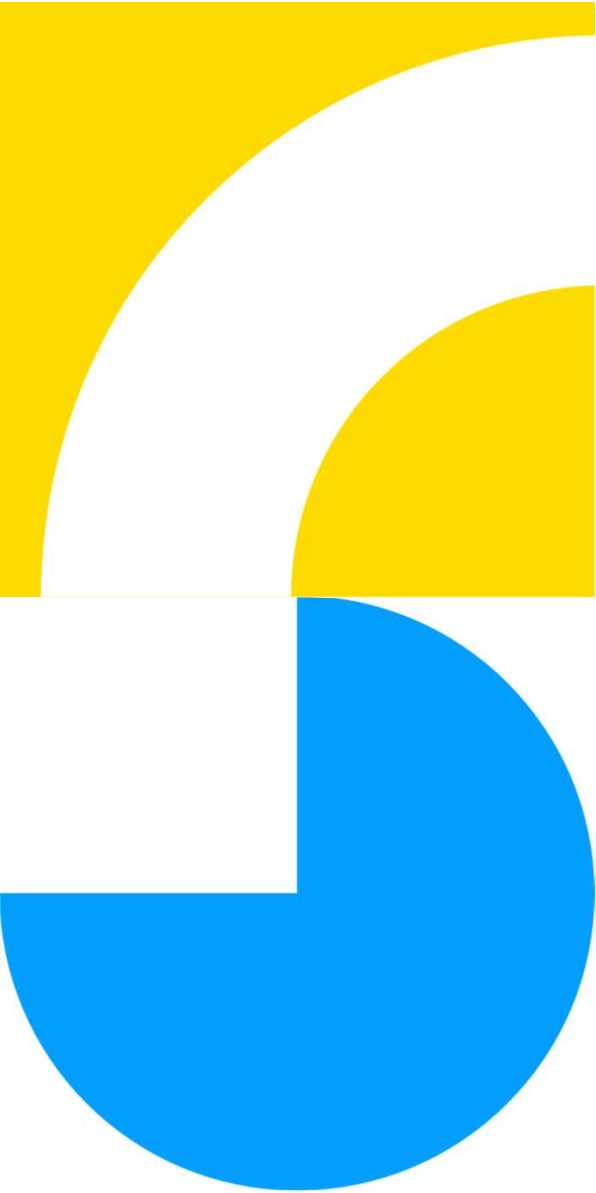

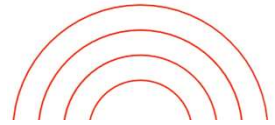


What Would Our Community Look Like without Child Enrichment?

Prevention Trainings We Offer



Mandated Reporter Training



Darkness to Light's Stewards of Children training is a 2 1/2-hour sexual abuse prevention training program that educates adults to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse.

Ensuring all mandated reporters and anyone involved with children or families understands reporting protocol, knows how to make a report of abuse, and recognizes the signs of child maltreatment can help prevent further abuse from occurring. While there is a legal obligation to report suspected abuse or neglect, we also believe there is a moral responsibility to prevent it whenever possible.

This interactive, evidence-based workshop explains how stress impacts the brain and why relationships improve individual and community well-being. Attendees will leave with practical ideas for taking action in their work, faith, neighborhood and friend networks.

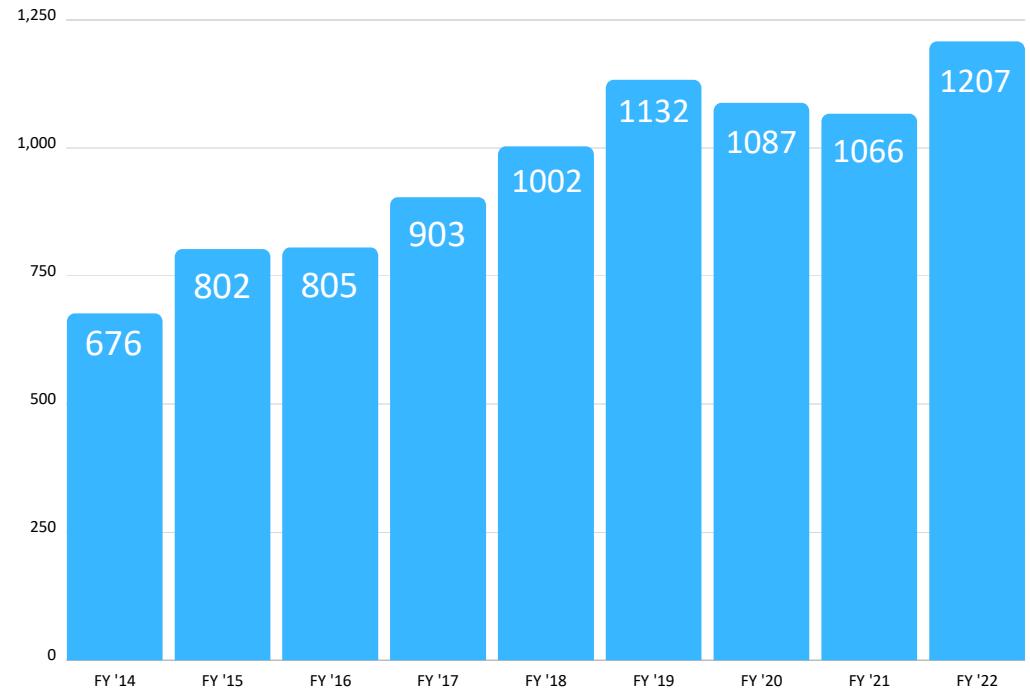

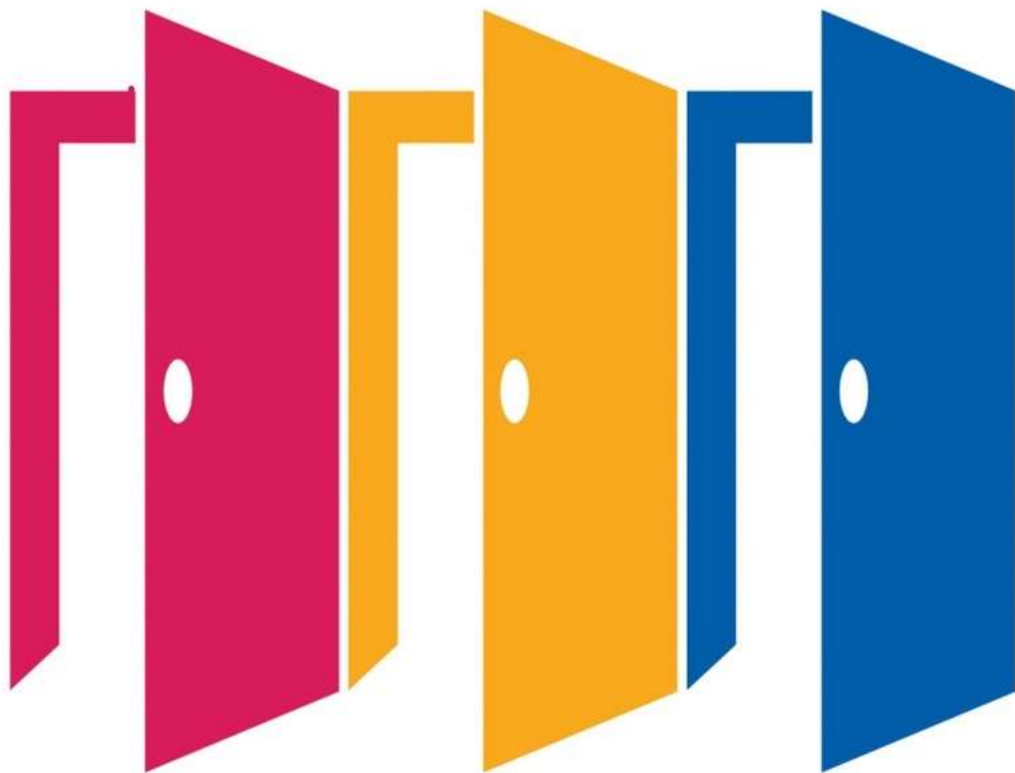
