Rotary Youth Exchange Scholarship

- **Outbound Program** - District 6920 Rotary Clubs can award a scholarship, valued at \$24,000.00, for a high school student in your local community to study abroad for a year
- Cost to award the scholarship is ZERO
- **Inbound Program** - District 6920 Rotary Clubs can host in inbound high school student in Georgia, for a full academic year
- Cost to host a Rotary Youth Exchange student for a full year - \$1750.00

Rotary Youth Exchange is Number One!

- Nearly 10000 high school students participate each year
- Professionally managed by Rotarian volunteers around the world
- Careful selection process ensures highest quality students and host families
- Well-developed and very thorough orientation programs and support infrastructure
- Rotary Youth Protection Policies help ensure a very safe program
- Value of Rotary Youth Exchange scholarship is \$24,000.00
- Low cost to family - \$5500.00 cost to successful and qualified Outbound student for long term. Airfare only STEP
- Zero cost to sponsoring Rotary Club to award the scholarship!

Long-Term Program

- Rotary's Flagship exchange program
- Approximately 1 year in length
- Immersion in foreign language and culture
- Live with local host families
- Become fluent in another language
- Attend a local high school

Short Term Exchange Program (STEP)

- Summer program
- Approximately 2 weeks with abroad with family and 2 weeks with exchange brother or sister in your home.
- Immersion in culture
- Live with local host families speaking English

Qualifications to Apply

- 14 – 17 years old
- Mature and flexible
- Strong academic performance
- Leadership experience
- Ready to become fluent in a new language and embrace a new culture
- Reside and attend high school in a Rotary Youth Exchange certified district
- Application deadline is November 1 each year for the following school year

- Become truly bi-cultural
- Conquer an extraordinary academic challenge
- Become uniquely prepared for university and adult life in a global community
- Learn and live Rotary values every day
- Make lifelong friendships around the world

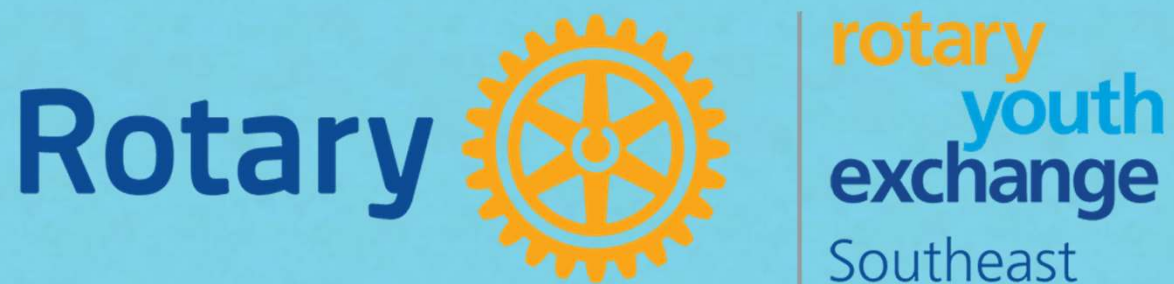

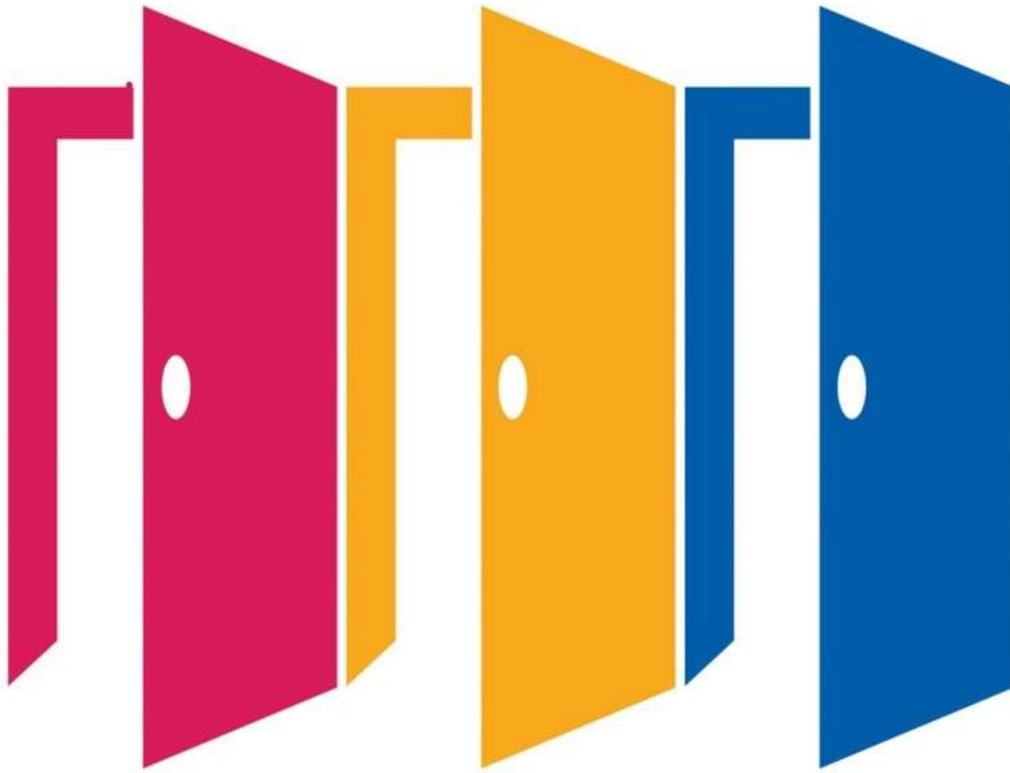
