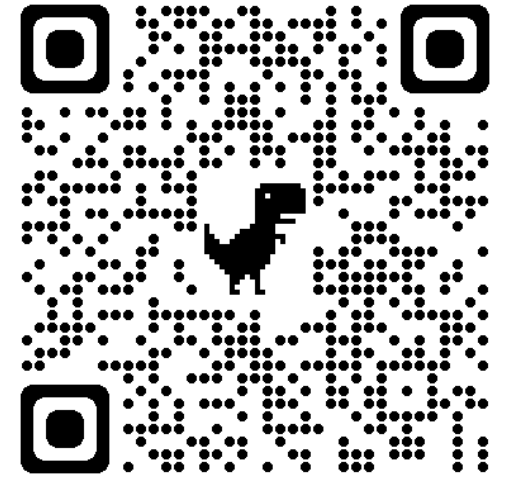

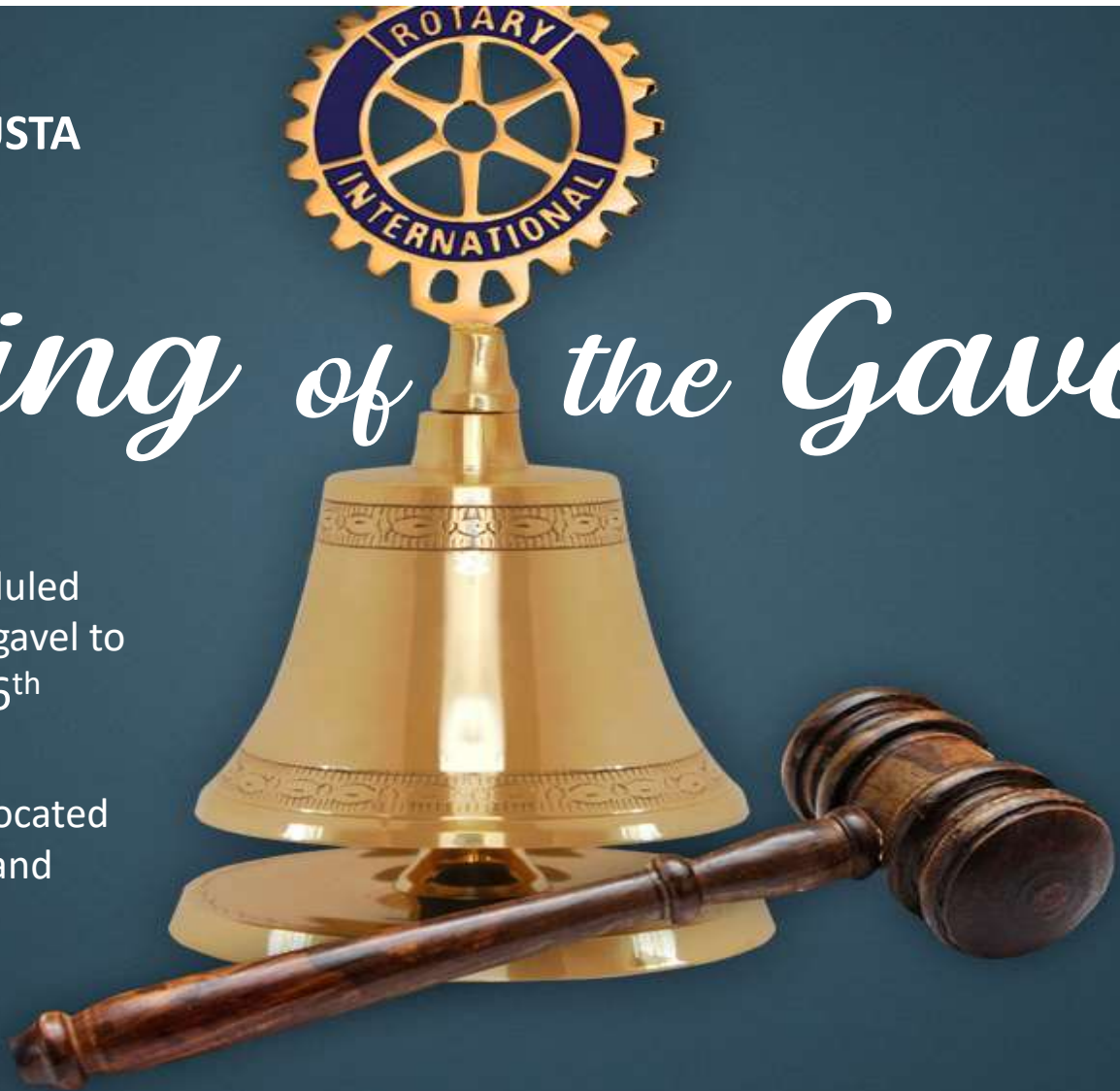

- VOTE IS GENERAL PRIMARY 2024

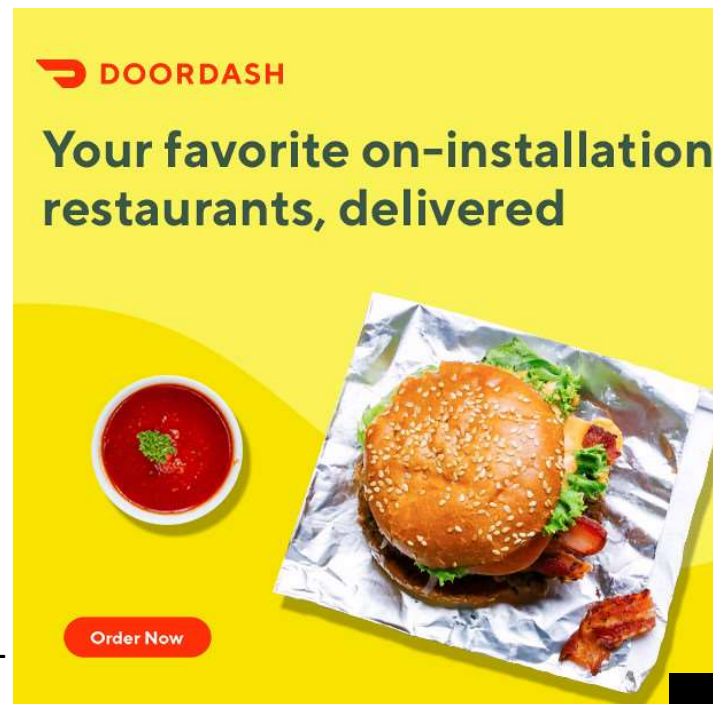

- TO CUSTOMERS WITHOUT WRITTEN APPROVAL
- CIVIL PENALTIES
- \$1,000 1/L \$2,000 2/L AND \$10,000 3/L

- MAY PROVIDE A WRITTEN OPT OUT

- CURRENT K-5
- CAN TRADE PLANNING PERIOD FOR
- COMPENSATION
- MAY REQUEST ONE DAY SUPERVISION
- TEACHERS GOT RAISE

- ASSESS JOB REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE AGENCIES
- ARE FOUR YEAR DEGREES NECESSARY?
- REDUCE WHERE PRACTICABLE FOUR- YEAR REQUIREMENT

- AGGRAVATED ASSAULT ON HEALTH WORKER
- ON CAMPUS
- 3 TO 20 WAS 1 TO 20 BUT NO
- MANDATORY MINIMUM.
- AGGRAVATED BATTERY 3 TO 20
- CERTIFIED HOSPITAL OFFICER IS AN OFFICER
- CAN EMPLOY NON CERTIFIED
- RELINQUISH THE SCENE ASAP



# CRIMINAL LAW

---

- GBI TO THE RESCUE SB 11
- GBI DOES NOT HAVE TO BE CALLED IN
- DIRECTOR DETERMINES NECESSARY TO AID
- IN BIOLOGICAL, CHEMICAL, DOMESTIC,
- CYBER OR NUCLEAR TERRORISM



# CRIMINAL LAW

- SB 44
- IF YOU COERCE, ENCOURAGE, DIRECT
- MEMBERSHIP IN STREET GANG
- 5 TO 20 AND NOW MANDATORY MIN.
- CAN GET LESSEER SENTENCE
- IF PROVIDE SUBSTANTIAL ASSISTANCE
- THIS HELPS HIGHER UPS OR LIARS

- TEACHERS GOT RAISE \$2,000
- LAW ENFORCEMENT GOT RAISE \$4,000 TO \$6,000
- NOT RC SO
- HOPE FULLY FUNDED



# LEGISLATION IS HARD BUT NOT WHAT YOU THINK

- SB 140 –TRANS RIGHTS BILL
- SB 92 –PROSECUTOR OVERSIGHT BILL
- Sb 222- VOTING BILLS
- 1,180 BILLS FILED NOT INCLUDING RESOLUTIONS
- 320 SIGNED BY GOVERNOR
- 193 WERE COUNTY OR CITY BILLS
- THUS ONLY 127 TRUE STATEWIDE BILLS
- 10 PERCENT OF ALL BILLS SUBMITTED ARE SIGNED
