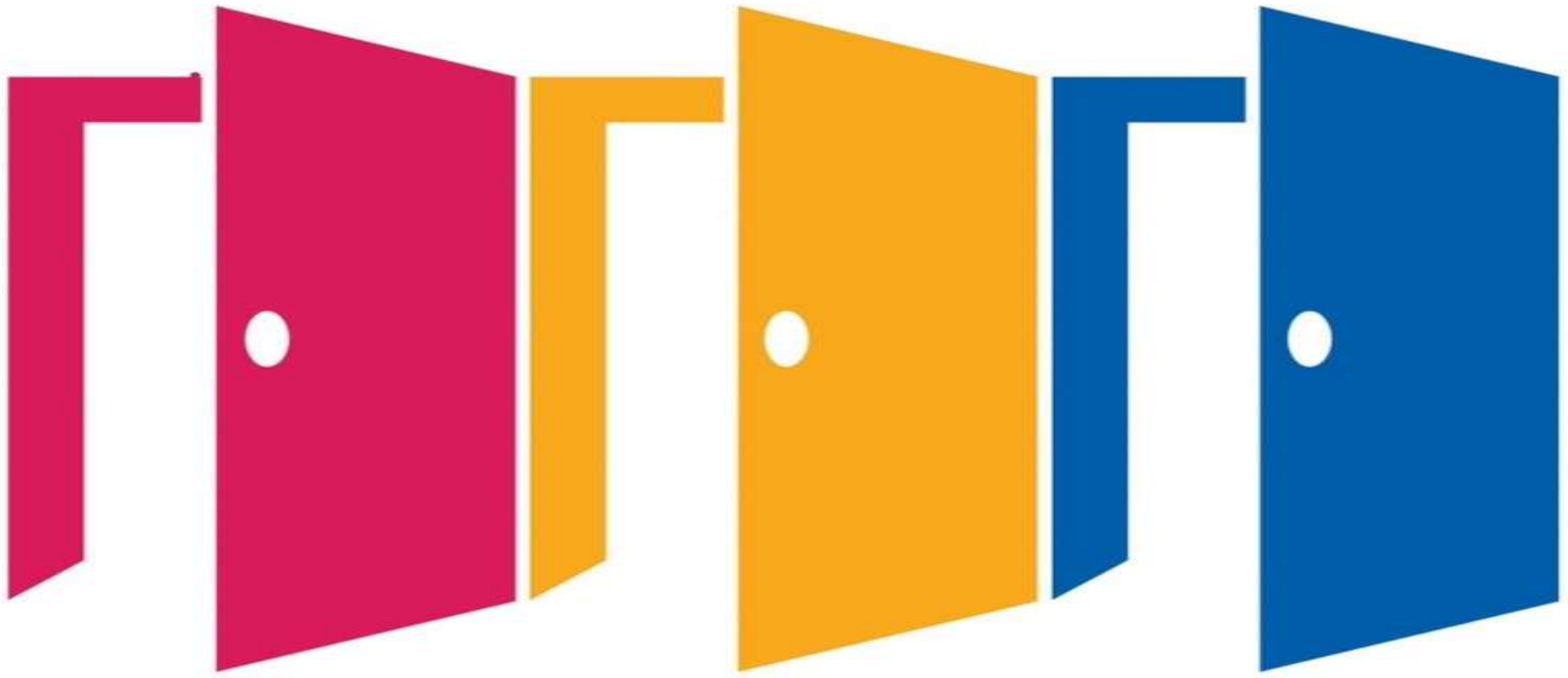

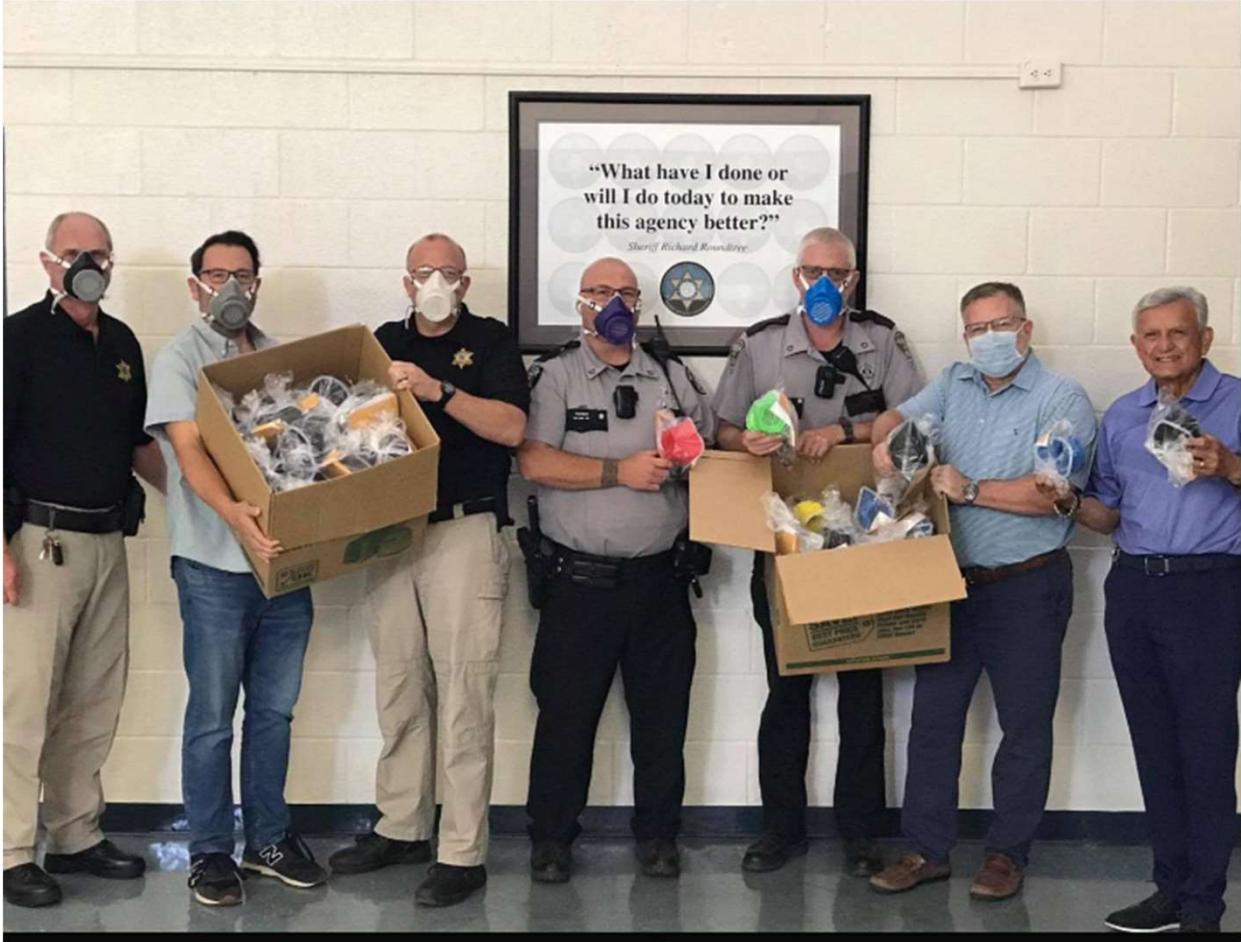

Improving Chronic Disease Management

Patients who benefit from the Saving Lives with Medicines Program demonstrate a clinical improvement in the management of their hypertension, diabetes, high cholesterol, and asthma. In the first three years of the program, more than 50% served in each of these disease categories reported a clinical improvement.

- 11 members sorted food for distribution

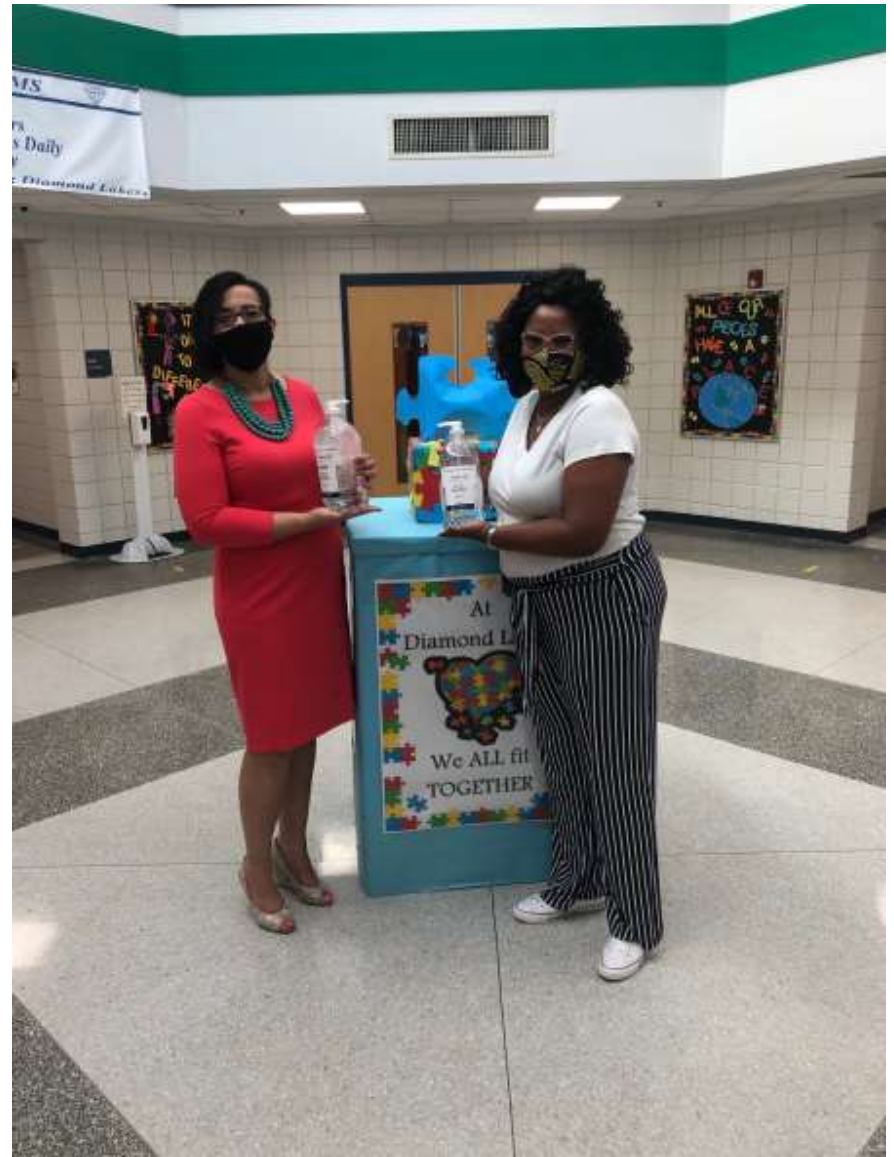

Global Grants

Global Grant 2119523 is the battle for knowledge project in Serbia, now known as Hearts of Europe Rotary District 2483 for 100 schools. The project focuses on improving the technical conditions for teaching and provides mBot robotics and curriculum to schools. The project budget is \$76,185. The Downtown Savannah club is the lead club from our district. We contributed \$1,050. District Designated Funds for 6920 is \$15,000. There are six clubs in 6920 participating. There are 18 other clubs participating from districts 2483 and 1911. \$20,000 is being funded by the World Fund and \$20,000 is jointly funded by USAID and The Rotary Foundation.



Global Grants

Global Grant 2122375 is the mobile cardiac screening unit led by the Rotary Club of Kadapa, India. The project budget is \$76,693 and the Rotary Foundation approved \$37,222 from the World Fund. We are the sponsor club with a contribution of \$1,050. Additional clubs participating are the Rotary Club of Downtown Macon at \$1,050 and The Rotary Club of Camden County at \$262. District 6920 is contributing \$7,000. Total district designated funds is \$37,222 when including the \$26,222 from District 3160.

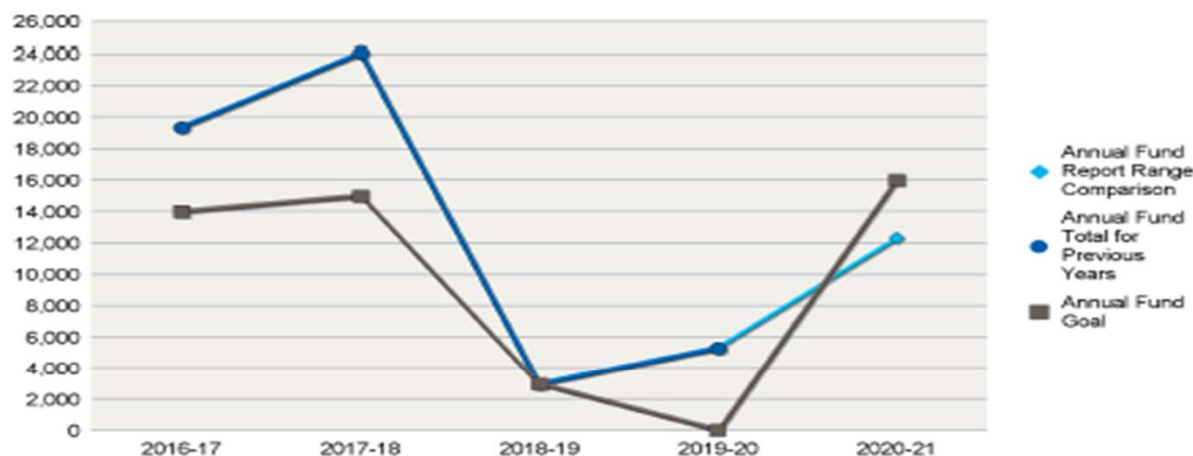

 - Polio Plus receives 2 for 1 match from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and a 1 for 1 match from the World Fund. Therefore, the total match is 3 for 1. Our \$10,095.65 contribution received a match of \$30,286.95.

Total impact for the foundation was \$52,713.95
