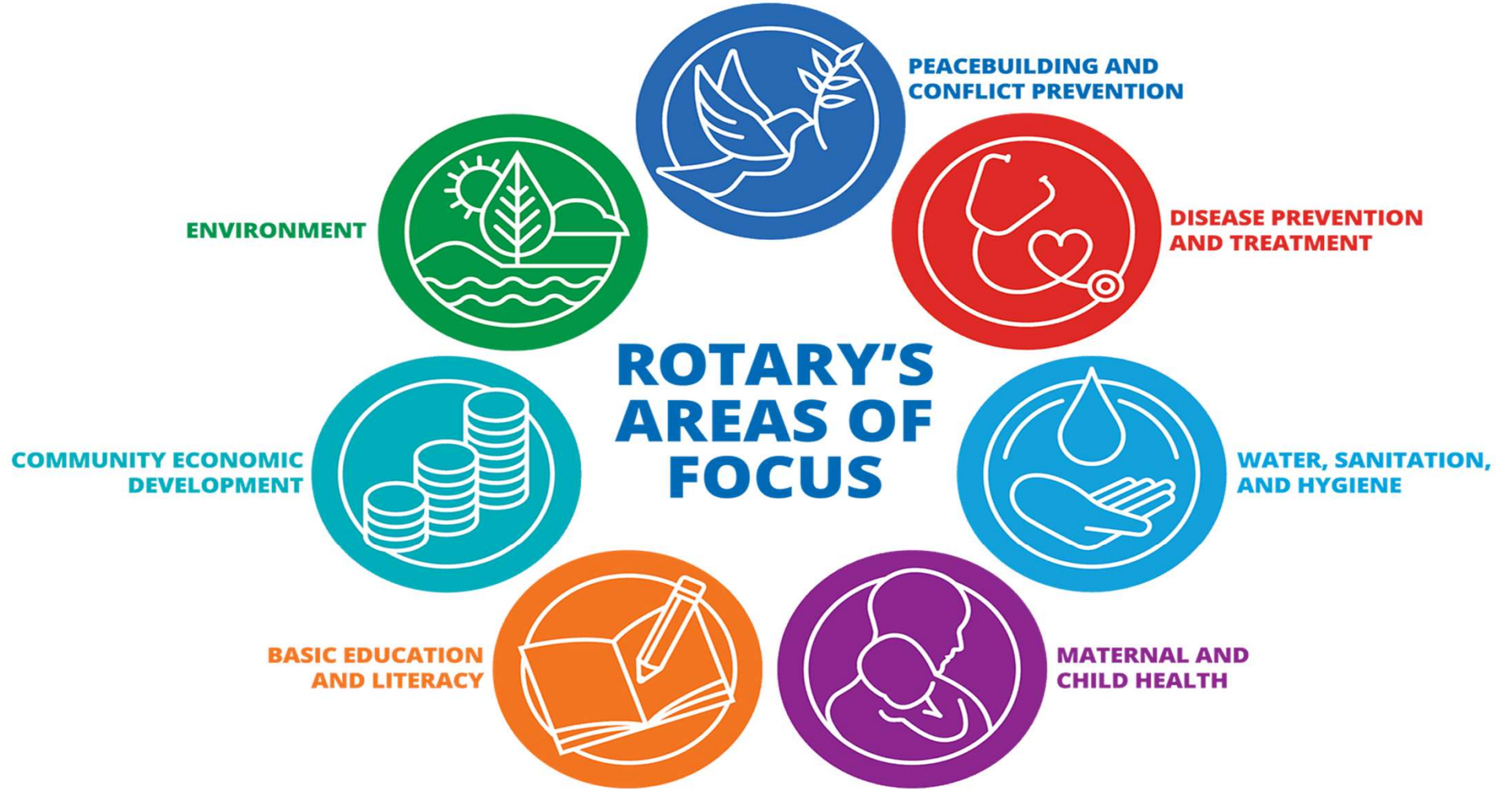

PAUL HARRIS FELLOW RECOGNITION

Donors become Paul Harris Fellows when they earn 1,000 recognition points.



This can be done in a few ways:

- By contributing \$1,000 to eligible funds
- By being given 1,000 recognition points by another donor.
- By combining direct donations with points transferred by others

LEADERS IN PHILANTHROPY

The Paul Harris Society recognizes Rotary members and friends of The Rotary Foundation who elect to contribute \$1,000 or more each year to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus Fund, or to approved global grants.

- The Paul Harris Society is group of more than 25,000 philanthropic leaders around the world.
- PHS members contributed almost 20% of all of the money donated to the Annual Fund in 2019-20.
- Donations fund both local and international projects.
- Donors are eligible to earn recognition and donor credit.

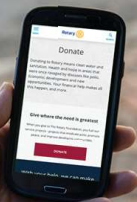

Rotary Foundation Matching Points Program

The Rotary Foundation's matching points program awards donors with points for every dollar they contribute to the Annual Programs Fund, Polio Plus, or approved Matching Grant:

- **Points for every dollar:** Donors receive one point for every dollar contributed.
- **Points count toward Paul Harris achievement:** Points can be used to achieve a Paul Harris Fellow (PHF) designation.
- **Points can be transferred:** Points can be transferred to help someone else achieve a PHF designation.
- **Points are available for life:** Points are available for the life of the donor.
