

In September 2019, *Hurricane Dorian* came to Grand Bahama and stayed! Days of rain created high waters never seen before by an island that has seen its share of hurricanes over the years.

The Rand Memorial Hospital in Freeport, the only hospital on GBI to serve 50,000 island residents, did not escape Dorian's fury. Today, the building repairs are almost completed, but there is still a great need for hospital equipment to replace what was damaged.

Five Rotary Clubs on Grand Bahama with 2 Rotaract Clubs have created Project GBI Rx to help replace the damaged hospital equipment. Your donations to GBI Rx up to a total of \$100,000 will be matched by a grant from the Rotary Club of Miami Foundation.
