DISTRICT FOUNDATION CHAIR

ROLE:

To serve as the District liaison overseeing the Foundation Team which assists and trains Rotary Club members in the identification, prioritization, planning, implementation and evaluation of Global Grants, District Grants, WCS, Major Donors, Benefactors, Bequest Society, Global Scholars and Paul Harris Giving.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

To develop, recruit speakers and facilitate the Foundation-related training components at the District Training(s) and District Assembly. This includes: Grants; World Community Service; Paul Harris Society, and The Rotary Foundation.

To facilitate the Foundation Team which supports the functions of the Clubs in implementing their Foundation. This includes:

To conduct quarterly status meetings with the Chairs of the Foundation Team.

To become familiar with Foundation projects being conducted within our District and identify Rotarians who could serve as mentors for other clubs.

To assist Club Foundation Chairs as requested, in their training, program logistics and problem solving efforts as needed.

To serve as the Foundation Liaison to the District Leadership Team.

To assist at other District/Club activities, including events and meetings as requested by the District Governor.

QUALIFICATIONS:

You have been a Rotarian in good standing with your club for at least three years.

You have lead/organized/participated in various service projects.

Having served as a Service (especially Foundation) Chair of your Club is preferred.

Must have District and/or Global Grant experience.

Having knowledge of successful Foundation projects originating from other clubs is a plus.

TERM OF OFFICE: Three years- at the discretion of the standing District Governor.
