Job Description

Purpose: To support the Rotaract program operations and communications in the District.

Qualifications: Appointed by the District Governor, the Rotaract Chair must be an active Rotarian in the district.

Duties and Responsibilities: Working under the direction of the District Governor or designee and Youth Service Chair, the individual

- Provide support and guidance to clubs with Rotaract chapters or clubs interested in establishing Rotaract chapters;
- Maintain a contact list of District Rotaract Chapters and their requisite sponsors and club liaisons;
- Promote an understanding of Rotaract through regular contacts with clubs and district leaders;
- Distribute information from Rotary International and examples of effective implementation of Rotaract at district meetings, to clubs and Rotaract Chapters;
- Provide information and examples of exemplary practices to strengthen club Rotaract activities and Rotaract Chapter operations;
- Encourage and assist club Rotaract chairs/liaisons in carrying out their responsibilities;
- Encourage clubs in the district to determine local needs that could benefit from the Rotaract.
