Job Description

Purpose: The activities and organization of a Rotary district exist to help the individual Rotary clubs advance the Object of Rotary by providing initiatives to foster fellowship activities, support community and international service opportunities, advance international understanding and goodwill, and ensure high ethical standards in all endeavors. In order to accomplish this as well as continuity of operations from one leadership team to the next, Rotary International encourages Rotary clubs and districts to develop strategic plans and align them with the RI Strategic Plan.

Qualifications: The committee is composed of six members with the chairperson being appointed by the district governor. Committee members serve on a staggered basis with a new member selected each year by the district governor nominee. Priority should be given to Rotarians experienced in long-term planning, district programs, activities, and financial management. Membership should also be diversified to include past, current and incoming district and club leaders.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Survey district leaders and clubs for their input not less than every three years in an effort to keep the plan relevant to the clubs.
- ❖ Recommend and annually update the district strategic plan for consideration first, by the district operations committee and, ultimately the club presidents-elect at their Presidents-elect Training Seminar (PETS).
