points about Germanna There are 10,000 students, with an average age of 36, who pay \$5,000 per year (or less) for schooling and fill important jobs across industries. The new education pathways at Germanna are healthcare, science, business, and social services. Within these areas, students can become nurses, dental or PT Assistants, accountants, HVAC/electrical/plumbing specialists, logistics and transportation professionals, cyber-security experts and much more.

By 2023, Virginia will need 1.4M people to fill the positions of retirees and half of those will require industry–

recognized credentials, certifications and licenses. Germanna works with local businesses to create apprenticeships for in-depth skills training and direct application. Ninety percent of student apprentices stay with the same company, and 80% of Germanna students in general stay in the local area. Dr. Gullickson and Stafford Rotarian Mike Cattell helped all of us better understand the great education and future that is afforded by Germanna.
