As I wrote to you earlier, this year my club RC Beograd Cukarica has prepared applications for 4 Global Grant projects.

Now I am very happy to inform you that we managed to close the budget for

- -GG2343865-Hearts of Europe-Empowering Women Entrepreneurship (\$86,250 equipment for 16 female Entrepreneurs) and
- -GG2343274-Hearts of Europe-Years of Ascent; we closed the budget of \$82,800 (equipment for 25 kindergartens in Serbia).

We are going to submit the applications for these two Global Grants in the next few days and hope to have approvals in the beginning of April.

The other two Global Grant proposals still need fundraising.
