

Our History – Polio Eradication



- Working to eradicate Polio for over 30 years
- **1985**: 1,000 cases per day (350,000 per year)
- **NOW**: 30 cases in 2022

average cost to fully protect a child against polio 430 million

children in total vaccinated in 39 countries in 2017 \$100 million

cost to conduct polio surveillance worldwide

- Rotary's philanthropic arm
- Started in 1917 with \$26.50

- Spent over \$4 billion on life-changing projects








Report To Our Community



Student Attend most meetings, 26 Rotary service

hours per year, reduced fees

Membership Types

TYPE EST. ANNUAL COST INITIAL PAYMENT

Regular \$900 \$350

This membership is for an individual that wants to be actively engaged with Newark Morning Rotary, including most of our meetings, service projects, and social events. Members are expected to make an effort to attend all meetings, and are required to attend at least 50% of them during the year. Regular members are eligible to hold all leadership positions, including club officer.

Corporate \$900 \$350

This membership is geared towards an organization that would like to have multiple employees share the duties of Rotary club membership. A maximum of four (4) individuals from the organization can be active participants in our club activities.

- one (1) person is designated as the primary member, and that person's name will be recorded with Rotary International as the member.
- meals will be invoiced assuming 1 member per meeting. If more than 1 person attends a meeting, the additional meals will be billed at the current meal rate.
- Corporate members may hold committee and many leadership roles, but CAN NOT be elected as a club officer.

Service \$444 \$200

This membership is for individuals who would like to be engaged with our service projects and activities, but cannot attend 50% of our club meetings due to other commitments.

- will be invoiced only for meals at meetings you attend
- required to attend at least 1 club meeting per month
- must participate a minimum of 26 hours per year of club-sponsored service projects. Service hours are to be reported to the club secretary at least once per quarter.
- Service members may hold committee and many leadership roles, but CAN NOT be elected as a club officer

TYPE EST. ANNUAL COST INITIAL PAYMENT

Student \$300 \$100

This membership is for students (typically college undergraduate and graduate programs) with a current student ID.

- attendance requirements are the same as a Regular member
- meal fees for our weekly breakfasts are waived
- must participate in a minimum of 26 hours per year of club-sponsored service projects. Service hours are to be reported to the club secretary at least once per quarter.
- Student members can hold committee leadership roles, but CAN NOT be elected to club director or officer positions.

Rotary Fees & Dues

Annual Dues: \$200 per year includes club (Newark Morning Rotary), District (7630) and Rotary International dues.

Paul Harris Sustaining: \$100 per year. We ask all members to voluntarily donate annually to The Rotary Foundation, to support Rotary's efforts throughout the world. Additional contributions are welcomed.

Meals: \$12 per breakfast.

Other activities: Fees vary for other optional and/or social activities like periodic happy hours, road trips and celebratory events.

Estimated Annual Costs listed reflect only dues (\$200), the minimum suggested Rotary Foundation giving amount (\$100), and meals. Additional optional Foundation giving and participation in optional Rotary events may add to your annual Rotary-related spending.

All fees and dues are as of January 1, 2018, and are subject to change.
