

Last week's speaker was our own Dan Zaloudek. His talk was entitled "Koch. It's the Real Thing". Dan's take on Koch Industries was strictly his own personal observations based on his years of experience with the company. Dan's working background was with Exxon when he joined Koch. Koch Industries, Inc. is an American multinational corporation based in Wichita. Kansas. Its subsidiaries are involved in the manufacturing, refining, and distribution of petroleum, chemicals, energy,

fiber, intermediates and polymers, minerals, fertilizers, pulp and paper, chemical technology equipment, ranching, finance, commodities trading, and investing. Koch owns Invista, Georgia-Pacific, Molex, Flint Hills Resources, Koch Pipeline, Koch Fertilizer. Koch Minerals. Matador Cattle Company, and Guardian Industries. The firm employs 120,000 people in 60 countries, with about 60,000 being employed in the United State alone. Dan shared that their way of thinking which is centered on Charles Koch's quote of "People should only profit to the extent they make other people's lives better" is a cornerstone of all their business enterprises.
