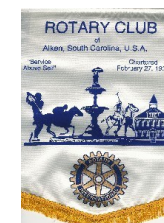

After that first year, Dr. Gary Goforth talked to her club about an upcoming trip to Honduras and said they still needed to raise \$1000 for the water project there. She offered to either write a check for the money, or she would go on the trip—which of course he accepted the latter. She went for a week and when she saw what Rotary was able to do to change lives by installing a water-well and when she saw children parading with American, Rotary, and Honduran flags, she realized she was now really a Rotarian.

Lorraine reiterated that if we choose to do good in the world, engage Rotary, and have fun—the life we may change might be our own.
