

#### PROGRAM LAST WEEK

Rotarian Beth Everitt introduced speakers Lisa Fallaw (East Aiken School for the Arts) and Becky Koelker (Aiken Elementary). They spoke about how the Rotary Readers program increases kids' reading proficiency at a critical age —

when they must transition from "learning to read" to "reading to learn." Those who can read proficiently by fourth grade are much more likely to complete high school and be economically successful in adulthood.

Ms. Fallaw provided an overview of the difference Rotary Readers have made in one year. The number of 4<sup>th</sup> graders at East Aiken who met established reading goals more than doubled, from only 27% last year to 64% this year with Rotary Readers. Among 5<sup>th</sup>graders, 2-1/2 times more kids met their reading goals this year with Rotary Readers.

Ms. Koelker spoke about the significance childhood reading has on communication skills, and the role poverty plays in reducing access to reading material. In middle- to high-income households, there are an average 12 books per child. In low-income households, there is an average single book per 300 children.
