

"Putting the Park Back into Our Parkways"

A report and presentation from Ryan Bland, Aiken City Planning Director shared the work of the City of Aiken Parkways Taskforce; a group with representatives from the Aiken Downtown Development Association and the Chamber of Commerce that came together at the request of the mayor and council in January 2018. The report is nearly ready for the presentation to the requesting group. The task force relied on an 1834 historic map of the grid pattern established in Aiken as well as records of the parkways within the grid. The parkways began being established in

the 1880's. Goals for the effort included providing for high quality urban pocket parks, creating community connection points, providing diverse and context appropriate settings and creating sustainable and manageable environments in the parkway system. The result of the groups efforts is a plan for a multi phased project that meets the goals and allows for a reasonable set of pathways and places with appropriate amenities and does not interfere with the function of the storm water system established some years ago to help alleviate runoff issues in the Aiken Woods. Appropriate amenities will include lighting, art; some of it interactive, benches/seating refuse containers, pet stations, signage and plantings. The plan includes cost estimates for each phase; so that each may be separately implemented as resources are made available. There is also provision for private as well as public contribution to the upgrading of our parkways system.


