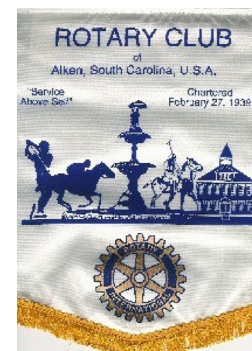

PROGRAM LAST WEEK by John Lindsay



Urging Rotarians to seek solutions for the public good, North Augusta City Administrator Todd Glover, himself a Rotarian, detailed the development and progress of the new riverside enhancement project creating South Carolina's "Riverfront". Recalling how the Renaissance vision of two decades ago has become the reality of North Augusta's riverfront today, Glover focused in part on the astonishing growth potential projected with the development of the U.S. Army cyber center activities at Fort Gordon, GA and the influx of new residents

who will require housing and municipal services. Coincidence played a part in the good fortune of the North Augusta project as Glover recalled receiving a call from Augusta Green Jackets management inquiring about the possibility of creating a new ball park in North Augusta. Fast forward to the summer of 2018 as the Green Jackets and the city opened a brand new and beautiful facility that, to date, has received two national awards. Displaying an impressive video portraying the riverside project to include condominiums, apartments and retail shopping, Glover detailed society's changing demographics and how North Augusta's new jewel will be an important attraction in the region's future.
