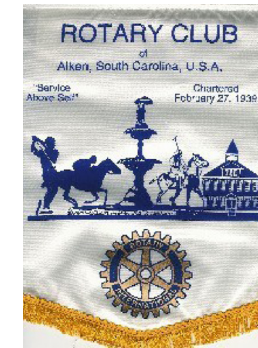

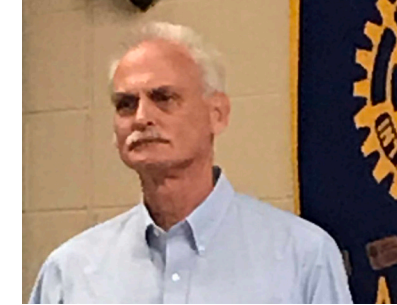

He gave us an example of his uncle who had bought many items over and over, because he couldn't remember that he had purchased them. They soon discovered that he had the beginning stages of Alzheimer. We learned that 5.7 millions are living with AD. Every 65 seconds and American is diagnosed with Alzheimer's Disease and without a cure, one out of every 10 living in America will ultimately become victims. That is why the CART fund

is so important. CART stands for Coins for Alzheimer Research Trust. CART was started in the Rotary Club of Sumter, SC. CART has given out \$7,200,000 in grants since 1999. These grants have provided funds to help with research to find a cure for Alzheimer. The 2018-19 7750 district goal is \$100,000. Rotary Club of Aiken has given \$5066 to date. All CART contributions are tax deductible. CART fund by-laws require that 100% of all donated funds must go to Alzheimer's research. There are many ways to contribute to the CART fund. One of the easiest is to put your spare change the CART bucket!
