

PROGRAM LAST WEEK by Jeff Baumgardner



Last week's speaker was introduced to the club by Corey Burns. Chanosha Lawton is the Chief Executive Officer of the Aiken Housing Authority. The Aiken Housing Authority is not something new to our area. Then mayor of Aiken, W.J. Moseley and the City Council passed a resolution on May 20, 1940 to form a housing authority and the Aiken Housing Authority was named on May 28, 1941. As Chanosha pointed out, that to most of us the Housing Authority is synonymous with Section 8 housing and Public Housing apartments. While being

an important part of the Housing Authority programs there is so much more. Programs such as the Summer Food Service program to name just one. This program consist of 41 sites that prepare breakfast and lunch for distribution to youth during the summer months while they are out of school and may not be getting breakfast or lunch at home. This program provided 63,875 meals during an 8 week period. Other programs educate for Workforce Preparedness, Home Ownership Programs and a Housing Trust Fund to help elderly people make needed repairs to their homes and necessary remodeling to keep their homes safe and livable. The goal of the Aiken Housing Authority and their many programs is to help build self-sufficient individuals. Giving them the resources and education to accomplish this is their mission
