



The purpose of the foundation is to promote, protect, preserve and share an appreciation of the architectural history of Aiken that makes it a very special place. Charlotte gave a brief history of several homes and hotels in the area that have undergone changes in appearance and function from when they were first constructed. She also highlighted some that are no longer here and only remembered through photos from the past. She also shared the changing look of the
