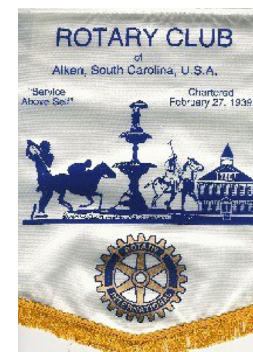

PROGRAM LAST WEEK by Tara Reeder



Our guest speaker at the last meeting was Vahid Majidi, the Director of the Savannah River National Laboratory. Mr. Majidi of the future growth coming to this area and it is most contributed to the lab. The lab can expect up to a 15% growth. Majidi stated that the lab is hiring. With the closing of the MOX facility, they have been able to hire some of those employees. Also, with the large number people retiring each month, they will continue to hire. That is related to pit production and cyber security. Mijidi spoke

about the lab's mission, but put much emphasis on the lab's purpose and that is service to our nation, county, state and at the local level. We learned that much of what is developed at the SRNL is applied at labs nation wide. Some of the other projects that are still in the early phases is manufacturing energy through solar. Most importantly and one of items discussed that he seemed most proud of, is the lab's safety record. Mr. Majidi emphasized how important it is to the organization to keep the employees safe SRNL is one of the safest national labs. There are 17 national labs in the nation. He says one of the biggest challenges is keeping adversaries from gaining access to the lab and the information contained inside.

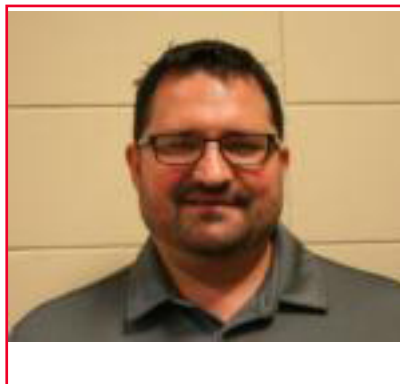
