

### PROGRAM LAST WEEK by Mallory Holley



Lieutenant Chris Medlin spoke to the club about the Aiken Civil Air Patrol on April 15, 2019. Chris Medlin was joined at the meeting by Lieutenant Norwood Bodie. The Civil Air Patrol is an official U.S. Air Force auxiliary that performs inland search and rescue missions. In addition to search and rescue, the Civil Air Patrol offers a Cadet program for kids age 12 and older. The adult members of the Civil Air Patrol volunteer for ground and aviation search and rescue, mentoring to the 12 to 18 year olds, help when natural disasters strike and provide civilian support to the U.S. Air Force. Recently, the local Civil Air Patrol provided assistance to the Federal **Emergency Management Association** (FEMA) with the hurricanes that hit the coast of South Carolina. The majority of the photos seen on television were taken by Civil Air Patrol and turned over to FEMA. In addition to taking aerial photos, the Civil Air Patrol provided

assistance with checking water levels and inspecting roads.

The Aiken Civil Aiken Patrol has 22 members and they are always looking for additional adults to lead and pilots to help with the aerial search and rescue. Chris also shared that the Civil Air Patrol has 10 planes that the volunteer pilots can use when participating in Civil Air Patrol at no cost to the pilot.

As a 501c3, donations are always welcome to help offset the cost of weekly meetings and other activities. The state legislature does provide approximately \$55,000 per year, but additional funding is appreciated. The group meets every Thursday from 6:30 to 8:30 at Millbrook Baptist Church and they occasionally have weekend trainings.

Chris emphasized the importance of the cadet program to help develop leadership skills, introduce flying to young people and to build good moral character in our young people. The adult mentors and the structure of the Civil Air Patrol help develop our young people and also help cadets that are planning to join the military. In addition, cadets are given to opportunity to get their pilots license at no cost.
