Members of Sequim Sunrise Rotary sell subscriptions to individuals and groups in designated areas in Sequim to erect the United States flag five times a year.

The five holidays are: President's Day • Memorial Day • Fourth of July • Labor Day • Veterans Day

- \$40 mailed by February 1 - 5 flag placements
- \$32 mailed by May 17 - 4 flag placements
- \$24 mailed by June 17 - 3 flag placements
- \$16 mailed by August 23 - 2 flag placements
- \$ 8 mailed by October 28 - 1 flag placement

HOW THE FLAG IS DISPLAYED

Each display address has a 14 inch PVC pipe (sleeve) placed at ground level to serve as a flag pole holder with a yellow or red cap on top. The location of the sleeve is marked either with a painted dot on the curb or a stainless washer driven into the pavement near the sleeve. Flags are manufactured in the United States.

WHEN THE FLAG IS DISPLAYED

- Whenever the holiday is on a Monday, the flag is placed by Rotarians on Saturday morning and taken in on Monday evening.
- Whenever the holiday is on a Friday, the flag is placed on Friday morning and taken in on Sunday evening.
- If the holiday is on another weekday, the flag is placed and removed the same day..
- If the weather is bad on President's Day, flag will be placed in June on Flag Day.
