PLEASE NOTE: If you received a grant from the Olympia Rotary Foundation in the past 12 months, you must submit a grant report prior to applying for a new grant. Organizations that receive funding are expected to send a brief report to the Community Development Chair at the address below, stating how funds were used and providing a statement of the impact our funds

Chair at the address below, stating how funds were used and providing a statement of the impact our funds made on those you serve. If we don't receive a report, the organization will not be eligible to apply for another grant until a report is received.

The **Community Response Grants Program** will not support or sponsor fundraising events, political candidates or issues or proposals that will create an expectation for continuing funding from the Rotary Club of Olympia. Grants awarded from our Community Response Program are smaller, between \$500-\$2,000.

All requests should be submitted online using the fillable form on page 2. This is the preferred method and will expedite your grant request. You MUST save the form to your computer, close your browser and then open the saved file, add the information and submit it using the bottom button. TIP: If you fill out the form without saving it first or closing your browser your entry data will be lost and the form will not be sent.
