Statement about the Fred Balz Community Impact Grant Program for the RFP.

The mission of the Fred Balz Community Grant Fund Committee is to provide funding that helps non-profit organizations address needs among fragile populations (e.g. seniors, youth, disabled, uninsured or underinsured for health care) that will enhance their quality of life and positively impact the future of our community. Preference will be given to proposals that meet an immediate need.

The Grants Program will not support or sponsor fundraising events, political candidates, or lobbying activities.

The purpose of the Community Impact Grants is to provide non-profit organizations financial resources (up to \$10,000) to have a greater impact on the lives of the individuals served. Recipients of the Community Impact Grants will be considered as entering into a partnership with the Rotary Club of Olympia to achieve a specific benefit for the community.

- C. Please provide a copy of the organization's IRS 501 (c) 3 determination letter.
- D. Please define your primary service area.
- E. What is the overall purpose of your organization, why does it exist?
- F. What specific project is proposed and what specific population (e.g., age, gender, ethnicity, number, etc.) will be served utilizing the grant funds?
- G. Please describe in detail the tools and methods that will be used to serve the specific population.
- H. What impact is the organization working to achieve?
- I. Please describe the outcomes that will be used to measure the impact.
- J. What specific metrics will be used to verify that the outcomes were achieved?
- K. Please provide the organization's operating budget as well and the budget for the project.
- L. Have you applied for or received other funding for this project?
- M. Is there other information you wish the Committee to consider?

Recipient organizations are encouraged to leverage the grant award to obtain other funding to increase or broaden the impact on the population served.
