#### **Highlights of July 19 Board Meetings**

- Club and Foundation Treasurers presented June 30, 2021 year-end reports; financial results for the year were in line with projections.
- District 5030 Youth Protection Policy updates were reviewed and annual Compliance Form approved.
- Club Secretary reported status of membership renewals and dues payments; membership going into the new year stands at 42.
- Pandemic-related obstacles to holding our Summer and Fall events were evaluated (see below).

# Updates on Challenge Race and Salmon Days 5K Run with the Fishes

- Challenge Race: Held in conjunction with Life
   Enrichment Options, two youth (one developmentally
   challenged) ride side-by-side in soapbox derby-type
   cars in a downhill race. Many participants are under
   age 12, for whom a COVID vaccine is not yet
   available. Considering the health risk to the youth,
   our 2021 Challenge Race will be deferred and the
   next Race is scheduled for August 20, 2022.
- 5K Run with the Fishes: Held in conjunction with Salmon Days, the Run generally follows the Salmon Days Parade route for which city streets are closed and traffic management is provided. This year's Salmon Days will be a down-sized event with no Parade, which eliminates the Run's route. Holding the Run in another location was deemed financially unfeasible given projected turnout.
