About Your Sponsor

Procedure:

- Proposed member expresses interest in joining Mercer Island Rotary.
- 2. Proposed member attends an Orientation session to learn more about Rotary International and our club.
- Proposed member and their sponsor fill out Proposal for Membership (PFM) form and submits it to the Membership Director. (If member does not initially have a Sponsor, the Membership Team will assign one.)
- Membership Director assigns preliminary classification to be confirmed with Membership Team and Proposed Member. Membership Team reviews PFM for completeness.

- 5. Secretary distributes first two pages of PFM to Club members for their review (10-day process).
- 6. Once 10-day review process has been successfully completed, proposed member gets invoice for membership dues and fees.
- 7. Once dues and fees are paid, member induction is scheduled asap. All inductions are currently virtual during a Club meeting.

Please be patient. This process takes time, and we are all volunteers.
