GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS

The Rotary Club of Duvall (Club) and the Rotary Foundation of Duvall (Foundation) are accepting applications for community grants.

Eligibility: Organizations eligible for grant funding must be 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations. Applications must have a Sponsor who is currently an active Club member. Club members may also apply on behalf of another organization. Applications for funding must address one of Rotary's six areas of focus:

- 1. Peace and conflict resolution
- 2. Disease prevention and treatment
- **3.** Water and sanitation
- 4. Maternal and child health
- 5. Basic education and literacy
- **6.** Economic and community development

Funding preference is given to applications that fulfill the Foundation's funding criteria of:

- Focus on the Snoqualmie Valley
- Reflect humanitarianism, civic, or educational scope
- Supported by Club membership and its avenues of service
- Meet the allocation targets of 70% local, 20% regional, and 10% international.

Applications must be received by **5:00 p.m. on April 15, 2019.** Grants will be awarded by June 15, 2019.

STEPS TO APPLY FOR AND RECEIVE A GRANT:

- 1. **Present** the project at a regularly scheduled Wednesday morning Club meeting that has been confirmed by the Club. This is not a requirement, but is recommended. Contact the Club Service Director, Lisa Yeager, at lisa@soundgenerations.org to schedule your presentation no later than April 8, 2019.
- **2. Complete** the Application form. Application forms are available at www.duvallrotary.org and are also available from a Rotary member.
- **3. Submit** completed application by email or US mail. You will receive confirmation that your application has been received. Applications can be submitted to:
