Thank you for considering the Rotary Foundation of Duvall (Foundation) for a grant. Please read the following paragraphs about us, the funding criteria, and the process.

WHO IS THE ROTARY FOUNDATION OF DUVALL?

Located in Duvall, Washington, the Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization formed by the Rotary Club of Duvall (Club), a 501(c)(4) organization. The Foundation’s purpose is to raise money, receive tax-deductible gifts and award grants and donations based on established areas of focus and funding criteria.

The Foundation provides oversight for the funds raised by the Club. The Foundation has a Board of Trustees that is independent of the Club Board of Directors. Each Trustee is a member of the Club. All trustees and officers are experienced in the non-profit environment. The mission of the Foundation is simply “Committed to Community”.

WHAT IS THE FOUNDATION’S DONATION AND GRANT PROCESS?

In 2018, a total of \$14,125 was awarded to eight projects. The grant process is competitive and all applications may not be fully funded. The funding cycle is annual with awards made according to the timeline document. Please review the following documents:
