GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS

The Rotary Foundation of Duvall, on behalf of The Rotary Club of Duvall, is accepting applications for community grants.¹

Eligibility: Applicants must be current 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations. Applicants must have a currently active Rotary Club of Duvall member as Sponsor. Applications for funding must address one of Rotary's seven areas of focus:

- 1. Peace and conflict resolution
- 2. Disease prevention and treatment
- 3. Water and sanitation
- 4. Maternal and child health
- 5. Basic education and literacy
- 6. Economic and community development
- 7. Environment

Funding preference is given to applications that address the Foundation's funding criteria of:

- a. Focus on the Snoqualmie Valley
- b. Reflect humanitarianism, civic, or educational scope
- c. Supported by Club membership and its avenues of service
- d. Meet the allocation targets of 70% local, 20% regional, and 10% international.

Applications must be received by Midnight of the 1st Wednesday in April.

STEPS TO APPLY FOR A GRANT:

- 1. Sponsor; find a currently active member of the Rotary Club of Duvall as your Sponsor.
- 2. Complete the Application form. Application forms are available at DuvallRotary.org
- **3. Submit** the completed application by email or US mail. You will receive confirmation that your application has been received. Applications can be submitted to:

- **4. Present** your project. Upon Foundation and Grant Committee review you may be invited to present your Grant Application to the Rotary Club as a whole on the 4th Wednesday of April at 7:30 am. Your Sponsor will notify you.
- **5. Receive** announcement of awards. Sponsors will notify their Applicants of awards no later than the 4th Wednesday of May.
