

The Okanogan-Omak Rotary Bachelor's Degree Scholarship Application 2025

Rotary is an international charitable organization comprised of professional and business leaders whose goals are humanitarian service, high ethical standards and the promotion of goodwill and peace around the world. The motto of Rotary is "Service Above Self". The Okanogan-Omak Rotary Club has served our communities since it was officially chartered.

The Okanogan-Omak Rotary Club will award a **\$4,500 Bachelor's Degree Scholarship** to an Okanogan and an Omak High School senior who is pursuing a four-year degree and who exemplifies the Rotary Motto of "Service above Self".

Eligibility Requirements

- Student is on track to graduate from Okanogan or Omak High School by the end of the current school year
- Student has been accepted to and plans to attend a 4-year accredited institution of higher education during the 2025-26 school year. Copy of acceptance letter required.
- Student demonstrates that s/he reaches out to others through community service either locally, regionally or internationally.
- Student completes and emails the Application Packet along with transcripts, college acceptance letter, and letters of recommendation by **April 30th** to Nancy Nash-Mendez at nancy@okanoganhousing.org
- Scholarship recipient will be notified on May 20, 2025.

Application Process

- Complete an application packet; available from the high school guidance/counseling department or online at Okanogan-OmakRotary.org
- E-mail the completed application packet to Nancy Nash-Mendez <u>nancy@okanoganhousing.org</u> by **5pm.**

Completed Application Packet Includes:

- Application with essay responses; be sure to include student and parent signatures
- Two letters of recommendation
- Copy of college/university acceptance letter
- Official high school transcript; if Running Start student, then official college transcript also
