

Community Clean-Up Forging Ahead

A number of Kelowna Sunrise Rotarians have taken up the challenge in keeping our community safe and clean. For the second Sunday this early spring, 14 Rotarians, including two members from the West Kelowna Daybreak Rotary club, completely observing covid guidelines, with gloved hands and garbage bags in hand, gathered over 100 pounds of garbage from the foot of Knox Mountain and its surrounding area. The earlier clean up experience in March had taken place in the Apple Bowl and surrounding area.



It is the plan of the organizers, which include Allison Kirkwood, Stevi Nagel, Stu Lang and Carole Farley, to continue with cleanup activities in the city of Kelowna each month. The next clean up activity is scheduled for May 16th from 10:00 – Noon, location to depend on need and ability to adhere to health restrictions.
