

## Humanitarian project "EVACUATION 200"

During hostilities, as a result of the military aggression of the Russian Federation, a large number of bodies (remains) of the dead remain directly at the sites of hostilities. There was a need to identify and further bury the dead. Members of our Rotary Club "Odessa Sea Energy" with Military Historical Center "Memory and Glory" (Odesa, Ukraine) participate in the humanitarian project "EVACUATION 200". The center has been operating since 2007 and has extensive experience in field research, including excavations at World War II battlefields.

The specificity of searching for the remains of the dead is greatly complicated by the fact that the trips made during the rotation have a large geography. Our activity is systemic in nature. Fighting is taking place in many regions of Ukraine, of varying intensity, which also strongly affects the further search for remains.

To implement the humanitarian project "Evacuation 200" in the frame work of 4 rotations of groups of searchers of 12 people:

## Automotive equipment

Cars with a body type "Pickup" with four - five-seater interior, diesel engine (Toyota Hilux, Mitsubishi L-200) - 1 pcs., - 20 000 USD Auto-refrigerator (Mercedes-Benz, Volkswagen) – 1 pcs., - 20 000 USD **Uniforms and equipment:** Military uniform (Ukrainian pixel) - 48 sets, - 4 000 USD T-shirts (pixel) – 48 pcs., - 400 USD Polo shirts - 48 pcs., - 866 USD Shoes - 48 pairs, - 3 466 USD Reinforced rubber gloves - 220 pairs, - 232 USD Sleeping bags - 48 pcs., - 1 600 USD Self-inflating mat - 48 pcs., - 1 466 USD Backpacks and bags are waterproof - 48 pcs., - 2 000 USD Cylinders (preferably composite) gas (12-27 l) – 6 pcs., - 750 USD **Computer equipment and UMB** Shockproof laptop with reinforced battery – 2 pcs.,- 3 800 USD Quadcopters - 1 pcs. - 3 000 USD
