CONTINUING SCHOLARSHIP

(for students previously awarded a Columbia Center Rotary Scholarship)

Applicant Eligibility Criteria:

You are eligible to apply for a Continuing Columbia Center Rotary Achievement Award, a **\$2,000 scholarship for college, university, or trade school**, if you:

- Received a scholarship from Columbia Center Rotary in the previous calendar year.
- Will still be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate in a university, college, or trade school in the 2025 – 2026 school year.
- Can identify a continuing financial need.
- Have been actively involved within your school or local community.

All application answers must be filled in where indicated. If additional space is required, please include on clearly marked separate sheets of paper (i.e.: title of section/question, your responses, etc). Responses must be printed on white paper with black type. Please use fonts no larger than 11-point (Calibri, Arial, Helvetica, or Times New Roman are the acceptable fonts). Applicants must submit all the following for consideration:

1. **The completed “Application Questionnaire” (please see the following pages).**
2. **A copy of your 2024 – 2025 academic transcript.**
3. **A copy of your 2024 – 2025 financial aid package.**
4. **A personal Essay as detailed in the “Essay” section.**
5. **(3) Letters of Recommendation that adhere to the requirements listed in the “Reference” section.**

All items MUST be included in the application packet, or it is immediately disqualified. Please submit your completed application as one single electronic file (preferably PDF) by the following date:
