Applicant Eligibility Criteria

You are eligible to apply for the Columbia Center Rotary Achievement Award:

A one-year **\$2,000 scholarship for college, university, or trade school**, if you:

- Are currently enrolled at Southridge High School, Kamiakin High School, Tri-Tech Skills Center, Legacy High School, or you are a Home-School student in the Southridge district.
- Will be graduating from high school (or an equivalent program) in 2024.
- Can identify a financial need.
- Have been actively involved within your school or local community.

All application answers must be filled in where indicated. If additional space is required, please include on clearly marked separate sheets of paper (i.e.: title of section/question, your responses, etc).

Responses must be printed on white paper with black type. Please use fonts no larger than 11-point (Calibri, Arial, Helvetica, or Times New Roman are the acceptable fonts). Applicants must submit all the following for consideration:

1. **The completed Application (laid out in the following pages).**
2. **A current Transcript reflecting the most recent quarter/semester of your attendance.**
3. **A personal Essay as detailed in the “Essay” section**
4. **(3) Letters of Recommendation that adhere to the requirements listed in the “Reference” section**
