FUNDS REQUEST POLICY (BINGO)

May 6, 2021



Purpose:

To provide guidelines for the consideration of requests for funds from the proceeds of the "Rotary Community On-line Bingo" for projects by individuals and groups from within the Rotary Club of Nakusp's jurisdiction.

Applications:

- Only written applications will be accepted (see reverse).
- Applicants may be required to make a presentation at a regular Club meeting.

Process:

- > The membership will be advised of financial requests, and be invited to provide input.
- The Bingo Proceeds Committee will determine whether to grant financial assistance to the applicant, and to what extent, based on Eligibility Factors below

Considerations will Determine the Level of Assistance, if any:

Mandatory Criteria:

- Applicant **must** confirm eligibility for gaming revenue disbursements with the British Columbia Gaming Commission: gaming.licensing@gov.bc.ca
- Applicant **must** reside within the Club's geographic area: (Edgewood to Trout Lake to Silverton).
- Project must benefit the local community.

Weighted Criteria:

Project aligns with one (or more) of Rotary's Seven Areas of Focus



- Applicant's may have provided previous service to our local community and/or the Rotary Club of Nakusp.
- Project benefits groups rather than individuals.
- Project has a long-term impact or benefit.
- Project provides an educational benefit for a local student.
- Project provides assistance to a person or group in need due to special circumstances.
- Funding is requested or supported by our local Interact group.
- Applicant has demonstrated success with projects of a similar nature.
