

EMPOWERING YOUNG WOMEN


To create opportunities that enhance education, safety, health, well-being, political and economic development that will transform girls' futures along with their families and communities.

Gender equality is important not only because it's a human right, but because it is essential for breaking inter-generational poverty and building peaceful and prosperous communities and nations.







The Gender Gap

Economic – 267.6 years to close

Political – 145.5 years to close, up from 94.5 years in 2020

Education – 37 countries reached parity, 14.2 years to close fully

Health – 96% has been closed, but # has declined since 2020
