Byron and Don both talked about the food baskets. For Covid Safety reasons Fred Meyer can not have Albina Rotarians or its guests putting together food baskets. Fred Meyer will deliver the food only to Head Start who will currently put out 130 boxes (for 65 families). The motion was seconded and voted on and passed.

Don will communicate with Amy of Fred Meyer and see if head start will deliver to the additional 30 families.

Francis will communicate with District to see if we can't service some of the 30 families if we can only return moneys to district in the amount of what head start cannot deliver for us.
