Old Business:

- •Alfred Alvarado from Albina Head Start submitted his application to join our club. Discussion was held and Lisa moved/Don seconded to admit him as a new member. All in favor. Don to personally reach out to him to let him know. Lisa to send new member packet, certificate and pin.
- •Dues were reviewed in light of new membership. New Business

Attached are some of the ideas of alternative clubs from the RI website. Lisa's idea of a theme was construction/residential remodeling, building on the ties we have with Neil Kelly Co. Discussion on the idea was mixed. Becky pointed out that her Interact group used to have theme years and it was a helpful focal point. Frances had concerned that it might negatively impact our NK scholarship applications as we typically pull from a wide variety of interests. Bob had mixed feelings on the idea and suggested that instead maybe Neil Kelly might want to think about becoming a corporate member. Byron didn't see such a theme hurting the applicant pool for the NK Scholarship because the scholarship was originally awarded for any post-secondary education.

The second idea was about holding our meeting, post covid once a month at The Oregon Public House on NE Dekum at Happy Hour. Again, opinions were mixed. It has been tried in the past and it was hard for members to get to a location in the late afternoon.

The discussion was constructive and inconclusive.
