We could have our usual raffle for Tom's Sun River condo with tickets but no banquet/auction, or not print tickets and say that each donation of a given amount (\$50? \$100?) will count as a raffle entry. \$9,000 is the most we can raise without a raffle license. A license isn't very expensive but involves much paperwork and hassle—and we haven't usually reached the limit. –Margie thought we could just write a letter asking for money; Frances was concerned that a large proportion of our ticket sales have come from Tom's friends and contacts, and he will no longer be a club member after he moves; Bob suggested hiring professional assistance. We need to take action on this very soon.
