Minutes from September 20 Approved: Motion by Don, Second by Frances -

OLD BUSINESS:

Bingo was a Success, we raised \$943.90 for Polio Plus, to be matched 2:1 by the Gates Foundation. Katie to send check to RI

Club decided to try to host 2X/yr. Next event to be in spring, to be billed as “Springo”

Brendon from Double Mountain was excited to host the event, and will be happy to do so again. Now that they have done it once, and have a better understanding for what is needed.

We had nearly a full room, only a few seats were vacant. Some lessons learned:

- Advertising:
 - 2 Tables saw signs posted in the neighborhood
 - 1 Table got the event pushed to them by eventbrite
 - Personal invites still accounted for most of the attendees
 - Event was posted on DacDB District, but was removed too early. Need to make sure to check the end date on the posting next time.
 - The event was not advertised on the Host Venue’s event page. We should make sure they post that.
- Timing:
 - In general we felt that 4:30 was a good setup time. There were a lot of people that arrived just after 5:00, but we only needed an additional 5 minutes to finish setting up. We need to have a better plan to handle early arrivals next time.
 - 1 hour before was decided to be a good amount of time for people to get food and socialize before the game. Timing was a little off due to the server starting a little late.
 - Katie had suggested to schedule some time afterwards for socializing. About half an hour should be sufficient.
 - Make a note that Poison will arrive promptly at the start time, not a minute before. It is important to make sure we understand the game format from her before.
- Other notes:

- Make sure that Wine is a Ticket option for future.
- Day of Cash sales were above expectations, so need to make sure we continue to plan for that.
- The question was raised about having additional Dancers, It was decided that the venue was too small for the dancers.
- The break between the 2 main rounds was good to get the messaging about Rotary & Polio Plus out.
- Format of the game: confirm format prior to next game in case there is a change.
 - 2 sheets with 3 games squares per sheet allotted per person. All game squares per sheet are marked each round.
 - 1st , Traditional Bingo
 - 2nd Round, (Using same game sheets) Some variation of Bingo
 - 3rd Round, (Using same game sheets) Blackout
 - Break
 - 4th Round, (new sheet) Some Special Variation
 - 5th Round (Same sheet) Another Variation
 - 6th Round (same sheet) Blackout
 - Break
 - Final Bonus round for the special Prize, new sheet purchased for additional cost.
