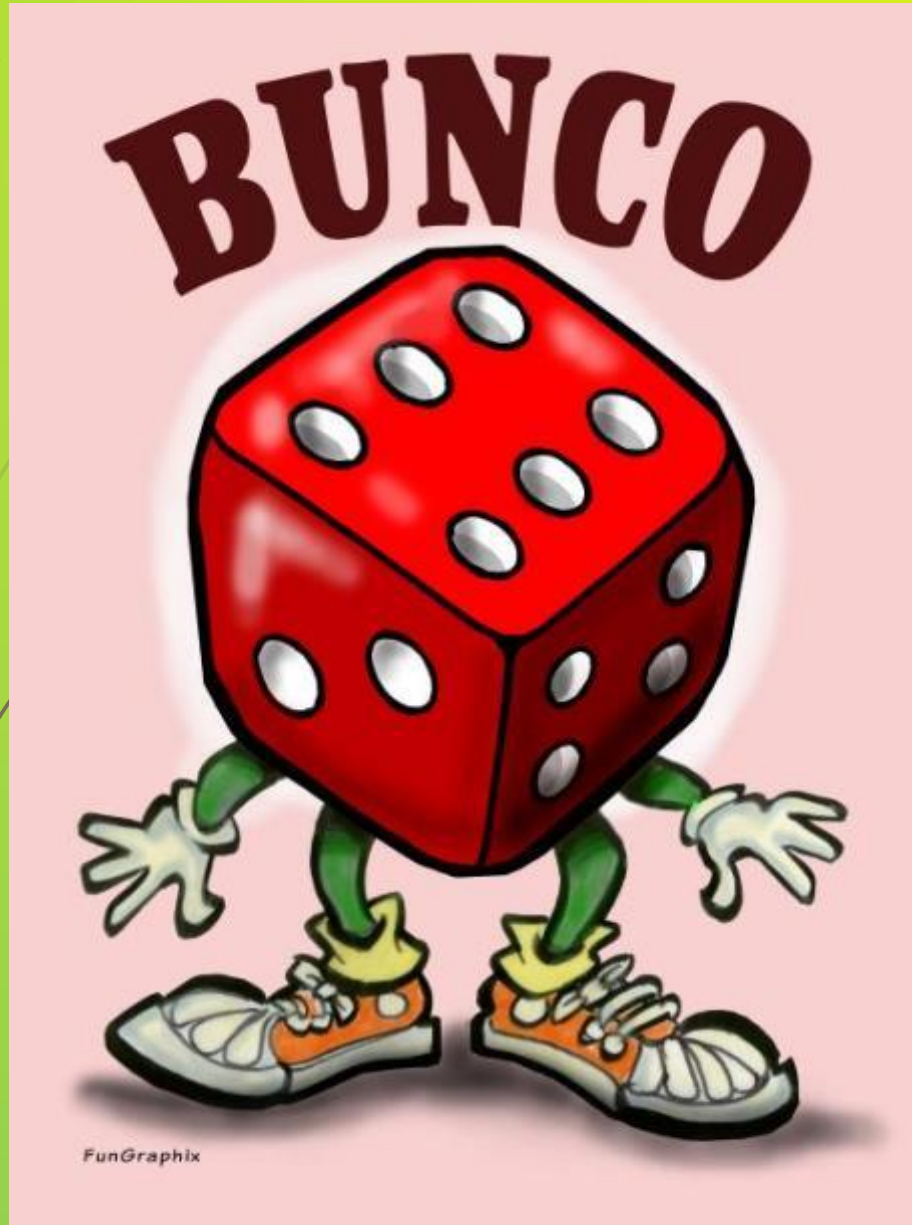

In Memoriam Paul Hancock former L.O. Rotarian



Paul Judson Hancock, 74, died in his Anchorage, Alaska, home on the early morning of March 25, 2017, after an eight-month battle with cancer,

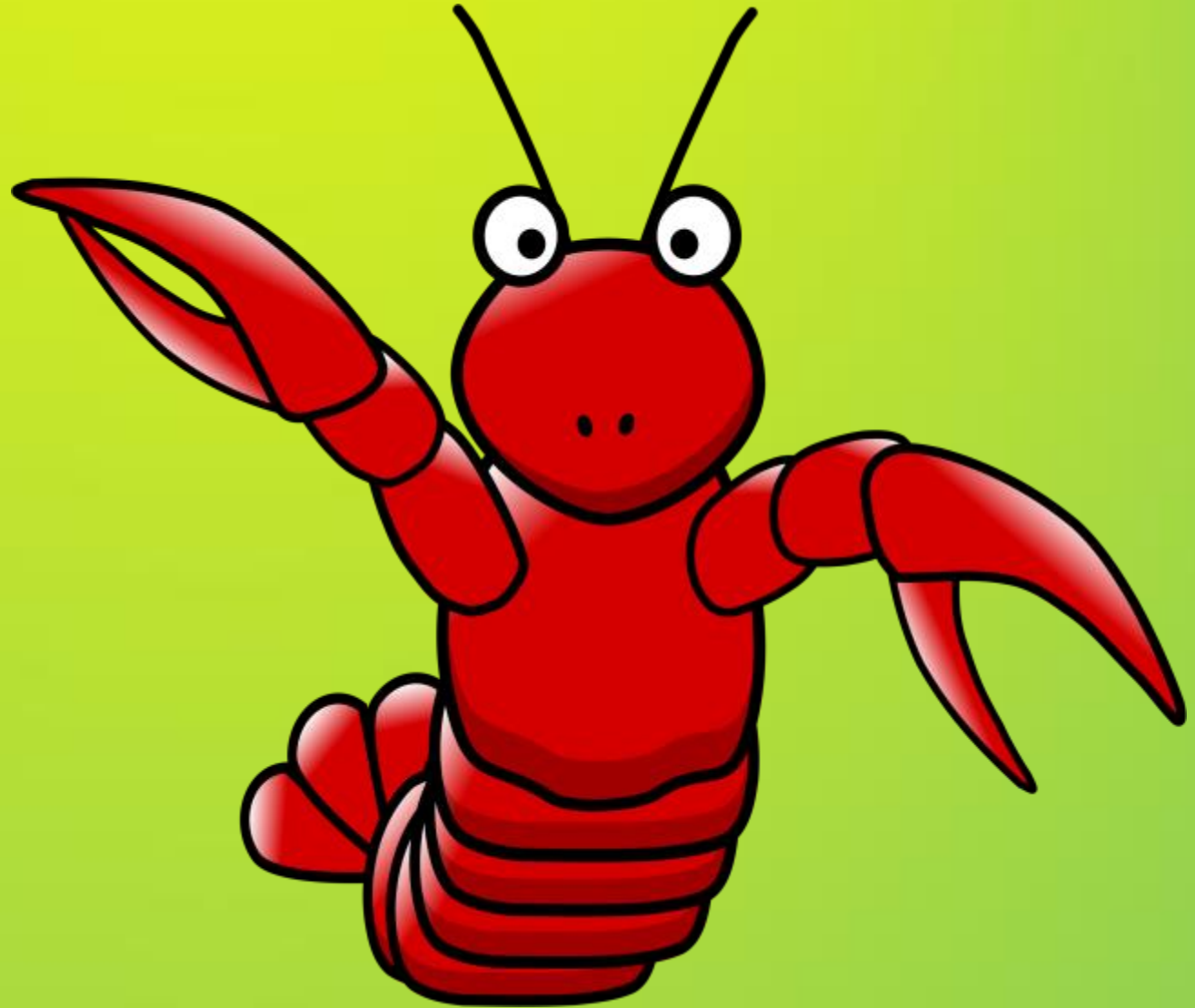

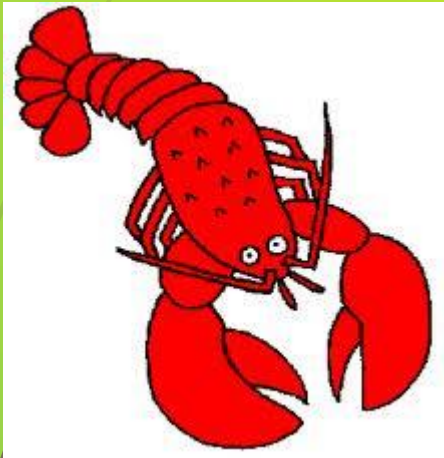
