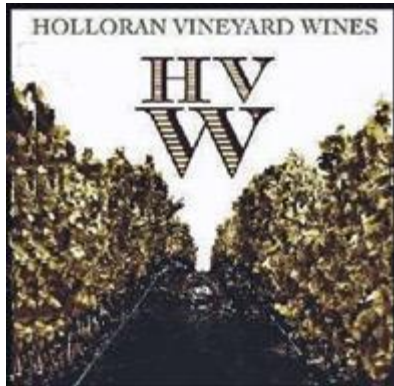


Ridge Taylor – 2 Truths & 1 Lie

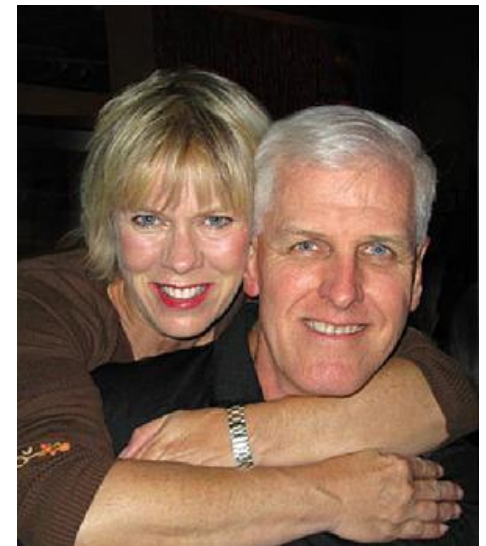
